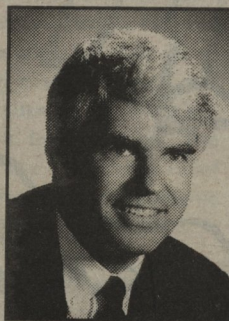

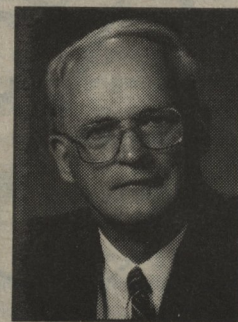

Island students are entitled to an educational system that is accessible and affordable. The P.C. Government has established a strong commitment to students.

- The Canada Student Loans Program is being improved. The loan limit is being increased from \$3,500 to \$5,100 per academic year for full-time students, and, from \$2,500 to a maximum of \$4,000 for part-time students.
- Special opportunity grants will be provided to students with disabilities and to certain other students.
- Deferred grants will be available to needy students and interest rate relief to low-income borrowers will be expanded.
- A Learning Incentives program will be introduced. This will reform the education tax credit, and increase child care expense deductions.
- A Youth Business Initiative program will provide young people with training, on-going managerial support, and access to start-up loans.
