

Winters Is Veteran Of Cabinet Newcomers

OTTAWA (CP) — Thumbs-up sketches of new cabinet ministers announced Friday by Prime Minister Pearson.

Postmaster General Jean-Pierre Côté, a dental surgeon who beat Conservative cabinet minister Pierre Sévigny in 1963 to become MP for Longueuil, born in Montreal. Graduate of the Montreal School of Dental Technology. Chairman of Longueuil's school board, diocesan commissioner of boy scouts. Sat on Commons committees on food and drugs and the pension plan. Father of eight.

B.C. Woman Gets \$50,000 Court Award

TORONTO (CP) — A 73-year-old woman now living at Nanaimo, B.C., has been awarded about \$50,000 in securities and cash from the \$484,000 estate of her former employer who died here in 1960.

Mr. Justice Leo Landreville of the Ontario Supreme Court ruled that a trust company of which she was a director exercised undue influence on Mrs. Ethel Margaret English six years ago when she surrendered to the Royal Trust Co. the gifts Lester Everett Weaver had given her on her retirement as his housekeeper.

Mrs. English was "instrumental in Mr. Weaver's spending the last nine years of his life in relative happiness, peace and comfort," said Mr. Justice Landreville's written judgment.

The judge found that a natural bond of attachment had formed between Mrs. English, a widow, and Mr. Weaver, a widower. The attachment "was not planned or designed by her; it was the consequence of her natural personality."

Mr. Weaver at first bought penny stocks for Mrs. English and eventually created a \$40,000 estate for her retirement.

Mr. Justice Landreville said Mrs. English received less than 10 per cent of Mr. Weaver's estate while the assets of it went to the Weaver family. The judge also noted that both sons—Judge Everett Lane Weaver of York County court here and William Erskine Weaver, an investment dealer—already were men of means before their father died at the age of 87.

Immigration Minister Jean Marchand, 46, central figure in Quebec labor movement since 1942. Elected in Quebec West, Nov. 8. Graduate of Laval University's school of social sciences. Resigned as president of Quebec's Confederation of National Trade Unions (CNLT) member of the royal commission on bilingualism and biculturalism, economic council of Quebec and other bodies to enter politics. Has one child.

John Turner, 36, minister without portfolio. A Rhodes Scholar, he also studied law at the University of Paris, M.P. since 1962 for Montreal St. Lawrence-St. George. Was parliamentary secretary to northern affairs minister. Member of House committees on mines, forests and waters, external affairs. Track and field star in university days. Former director of Montreal's legal aid bureau, the Quebec division of Canadian Red Cross. Former lecturer at Sir George Williams University, Montreal. Author of "The Senate in Canada," an essay published by the University of Toronto. Has one child.

Trade Minister Robert Winters, 55, industrialist born in Lunenburg, N.S. Elected Nov. 8 in Toronto-area riding of York West. Sat for Queens-Lunenburg from 1945 until his defeat in 1958. Was minister of reconstruction and supply, resources and development, and public works. Graduate of Mount Allison University, Sackville, N.B., and Massachusetts Institute of Technology. Held rank of lieutenant-colonel in Royal Canadian Electrical and Mechanical Engineers during Second World War. After 13 years in politics, returned to private life in 1958 and has been chairman of the board of Rio Algom Mines Limited and Atlas Steels Company, board chairman and chief executive of British Newfoundland Corporation, president of Rio Tinto Mining Company of Canada, vice-president of Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce and anada Permanent Trust Company. Held numerous directorships. Was chairman of board of governors of York University.
