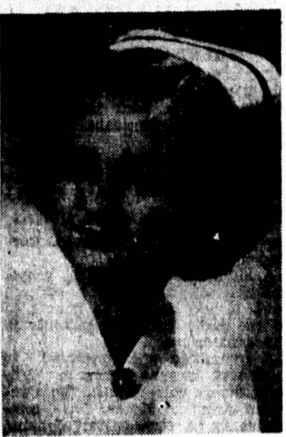

in speech. This produces a slurring effect.
If hearing tests are not made in the schools teachers, and also parents, can watch for tell-tale signs of hearing loss in children: inattentiveness (not immediately obeying orders or following instructions); leaning forwards or sideways; trying to hear; speech and voice peculiarities; excessive fatigue from tenseness of body and mind as they try to hear; and school difficulties.
Much help can be given to partially deaf children by means of modern hearing aids; these aids are as far ahead of the old-time hearing horns as the modern washing machine is ahead of the old-time wash tub. In the past ten years maintenance of hearing aids has been reduced to 1 cent an hour, their power increased from 100 to 1,000 times, their size reduced to 1/5 of previous size.
Properly fitted hearing aids help the hard of hearing to become a part of the community life.
