The terms of reference for this award are as follows:

### MAJOR NATIONAL ARTS CONFERENCE IN HALIFAX

APRIL 26, 27 & 28, 1978

This medal is awarded to a graduating student who has demonstrated to an outstanding degree qualities of scholarship and leadership within the University community. Recommendations for this award may be made by any member of the University community to the Awards Committee by March 31. Winners of the Governor General's Gold and Silver Medals will not be eligible for this award.

The Canadian conference of the Arts is pleased to announce that its 1978 Annual Meeting will be held in Halifax, Nova Scotia, Wednesday, April 26. As CCA represents artists and arts organizations across Canada it is imperative that members in the various regions have the opportunity to make direct input into CCA's policy development. This year the Atlantic members will focus their attention on the immediate issues affecting artists and arts organizations. Following the Annual Meeting the CCA will be hosting a major national arts conference open to all.

Recommendations and supporting material will be received in this office for onward transmission to the Awards Committee up to Friday, 7 April 1978.
