 They weren't breaking water but heavy swirls showed they were seeking food just under the surface. The system I put into effect was lazy and simple in the extreme. I'd nose the boat into the flags within nice casting distance of a bend and then flip the dark Montreal and Par Belle over the narrow point of flags and whammo, the water would shoot feet into the air and the glass rod would bend double. A three quarter pound trout requires careful handling in a set-up like that. They'll zip up and down that narrow channel like torpedoes and the trick is to keep them from diving.

 stands above all others — a half hour past high noon, a combination of gentle southwest wind, low cloud deck with a light peppering of misty rain at intervals—drifting in a boat up a black ribbon of water, that meandered with sharp twists and turns through a wilderness of flags, that boiled with the deep eddying swirls of feeding trout.
 They weren't breaking water but heavy swirls showed they were seeking food just under the surface. The system I put into effect was lazy and simple in the extreme. I'd nose the boat into the flags within nice casting distance of a bend and then flip the dark Montreal and Par Belle over the narrow point of flags and whammo, the water would shoot feet into the air and the glass rod would bend double. A three quarter pound trout requires careful handling in a set-up like that. They'll zip up and down that narrow channel like torpedoes and the trick is to keep them from diving.

Among The Farmers
 Federation of Agriculture News
 As the old year recedes into history and the new one rises with rosy cheeks upon the horizon, mankind traditionally plans to do worthier and nobler things. The mistakes of the past are not to be repeated, old shortcomings and failings are to be shunned, the clean sheet of the New Year is to chronicle only worthy deeds. Curiously, in spite of the fact that men have been considering these matters for thousands of years, improvement has come very slowly. High hopes and good resolutions seem to go hand in hand with backsliding, but gains have been made and while the human animal may lose ground from time to time yet in general the movement is onward and upward to better and nobler things.

FARMING IN 1954
 Nature provided the Canadian farmer with varied treatment in 1954: drought in some areas, floods in others, late spring frosts, early fall frosts and pests, all tending to aggravate the uncertainty with which farmers entered the year just now closing. The Canadian consumer was provided with an abundance of good food, some of which he purchased for less money with more pay than in the preceding year, and proceeded to criticize some of the projects which the Canadian Government used to help keep the farmer in business.
 The major farm organizations directed a greater share of their attention to marketing problems while the Departments of Agriculture which had long concentrated on problems of production began also to take an interest in the importance of getting the results of production into the hands of the consumer.
 The Western grain grower faced at the beginning of the year with large unsold surpluses, harvested one of the smallest crops of recent years. His position market-wise and price-wise was well protected by the marketing system which had proven its worth over the years. The Ontario cheese producer and hog raiser continued the operation of their Central Sales Agencies in an ambitious plan to cut down marketing costs and to return as large a share as possible to the producer.
 Prince Edward Island Potato growers after experimenting in a distressing period with a central selling agency for potatoes, decided on November 10th that with improved prospects for the current crop to give the established
