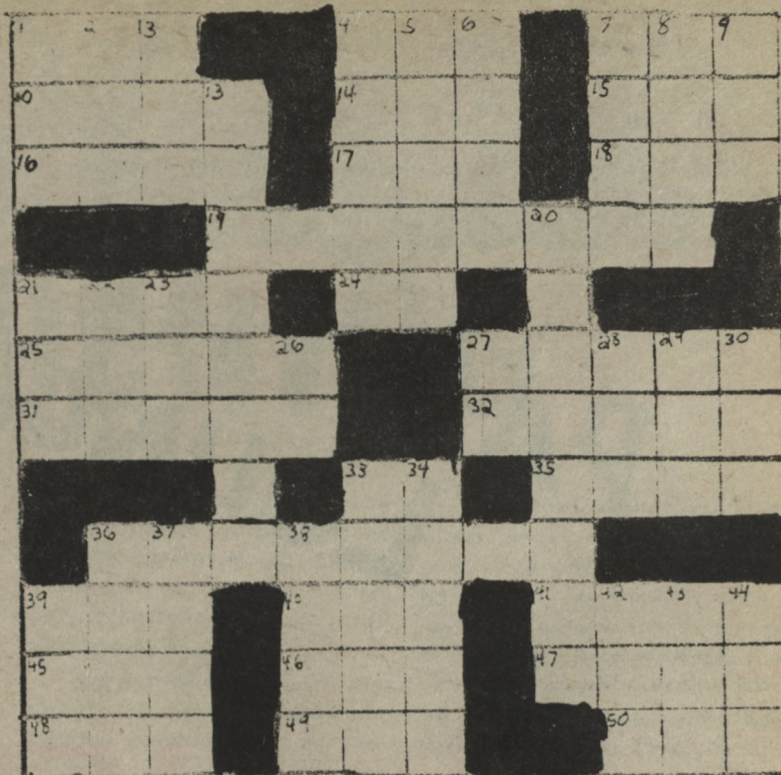
"My what big teeth you have!" said the girl as Harris locked the door...

## Crossword

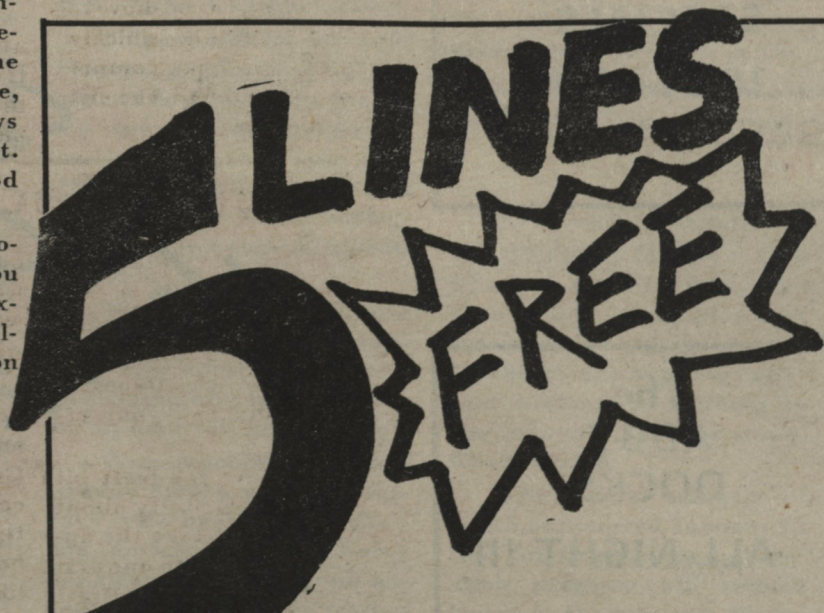
