

- adult at Point Prim on Jul. 28 (DW), immature at Beech Grove on Sept. 8 (JDM), 1 at Emyvale on Sept. 25 (JWa); **Northern Harrier** - 1 at West point on Jul. 19 (DW), 1 at Point Prim on Aug. 15 (DW); **Osprey** - 1 at Point Prim on May 29 (DW); a at park Corner on June 30 (DW); 1 fishing at Belvedere Pond on Jul. 1 (JDM) **Kestrel** - 1 at Johnson's River and 1 at Fullerton's Marsh on July 1 (JDM), 1 in Donagh on Aug. 3 (JDM); **Ruffed Grouse** - 4 at Eldon on Aug. 21 (DW); 3 at Tarantum on Sept. 15 (JDM); **Northern Lapwing** - first summer record at Fullerton's Marsh on July 13 (SMa); **Semipalmated Plover** - numbers down dramatically at Cousin's Shore this year (N&SB); **Piping Plover** - 1 at St. Peter's Lake Run on Jul. 2 (FH); **Black-bellied Plover** - - numbers down dramatically at Cousin's Shore earlier this year but 70 at Cousin's Shore on Sept. 10 (N&SB); **Whimbrel** - 60 at Summerside on Jul. 23 (JDM), 6 at Earnscliffe on Aug. 7 (JH); **Black-necked Stilt** - first record at Belmont Pond on July 14 (SMa), confirmed by Ray Cooke with photographs, seen July 24 (LH, GH); **Red Knot** - 50 at Schurman's Shore on July 23 (LH, GH); **White-rumped Sandpiper** - 1 at Bay Fortune on May 23 (JW, DG); **Curlew Sandpiper** - confirmed record at Covehead Harbour Sandbar on July 19 (MR, BdL, MdL, RG), photographed by RC and BdL on July 20; **Sanderling** - numbers down dramatically at Cousin's Shore this year (N&SB); **Ring-billed Gull** - 150 at Ellen's Creek on Aug. 4 (JDM); **Black-headed Gull** - 1 at Covehead on Jul. 24 (NP reported by RG); **Black-billed Cuckoo** - 1 with young at Skinner's Pond in late July (LH, GH); **Barred Owl** - 1 at Strathgartney Park on Jul. 31 (G&FM); **Ruby-throated Hummingbird** - at Point Prim, male and female on May 29, 2 on Aug. 15 and 3 on Aug. 22 (DW); **Northern Flicker** - abundant along roadsides in August often in what appeared to be family groups (JDM); **Pileated Woodpecker** - 1 calling at South Melville in early Jul. (CM); **Tree Swallow** - 1 at Point Prim on Jul. 28 (DW); **Bank Swallow** - numerous at Point Prim on Jul. 28 (DW); **Barn Swallow** - 15 at St. Catherine's and 35 at Green Road on Jul. 23 (EC); **Gray Jay** - 1 at St. Margaret's on May 17 (GM); **Pied Crow** - a venture west for a reported Black-billed Magpie led to the discovery of a Pied Crow at Miminegash on Jul. 28th (RC, JDM). This bird was mistakenly identified in the paper as a Chihuahuan Raven, a Magnificent Frigate Bird, and a Black Billed Magpie. A report was received a week later of a similarly marked bird at the East Point Lighthouse (SC via GM). While researching the sighting Ray Cooke was advised by Stu Tingley that a similarly marked bird was reported in New Brunswick but had not been checked as it was thought to be an albino raven. In mid-September, a letter and photograph from Marie Paquette and Gordon Grant identified the Pied Crow at Cedar Dunes on August 15-16th; **Boreal Chickadee** - 1 at Emyvale on Sept 25 (JWa); **Black-capped Chickadee** - pair feeding 5 young in cavity in red maple located 3.27 m off ground in branch stub created hole (SM); **Blue-gray Gnatcatcher** - 1 at North Cape on Aug. 29 (RC); **Cedar Waxwing** - flock of 20 at Dromore in cutover on Sept. 15 (JDM); **Philadelphia Vireo** - 1 at Macphail's Woods on May 23 (DW); **Canada Warbler** - 1 at Point Prim on May 29 (DW) **Indigo Bunting** - male and female at East Point in mid-June (FC reported by
