Application forms are available at the Registrar's Office and must be completed by **Monday, 17 March**. The graduation fee must be paid by **Monday, 21 April**, as follows:

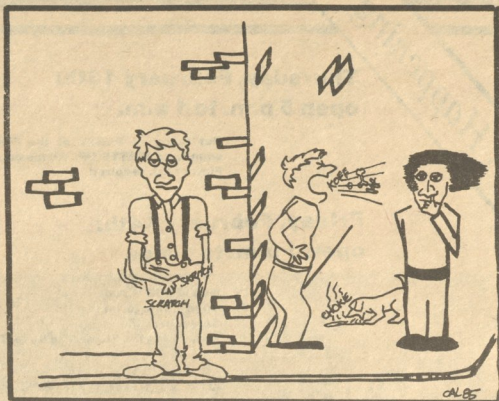
