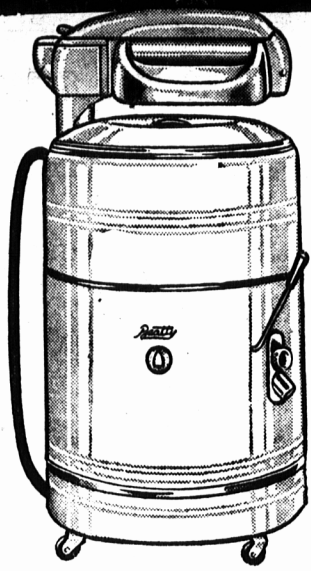

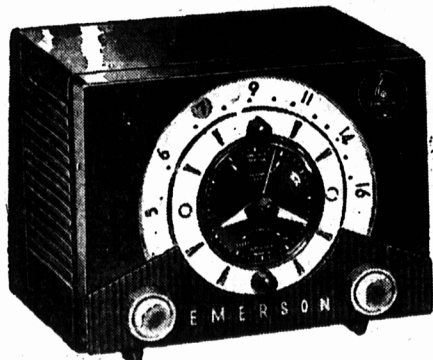

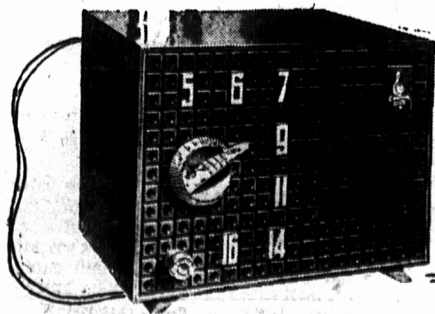

Pleasant View.

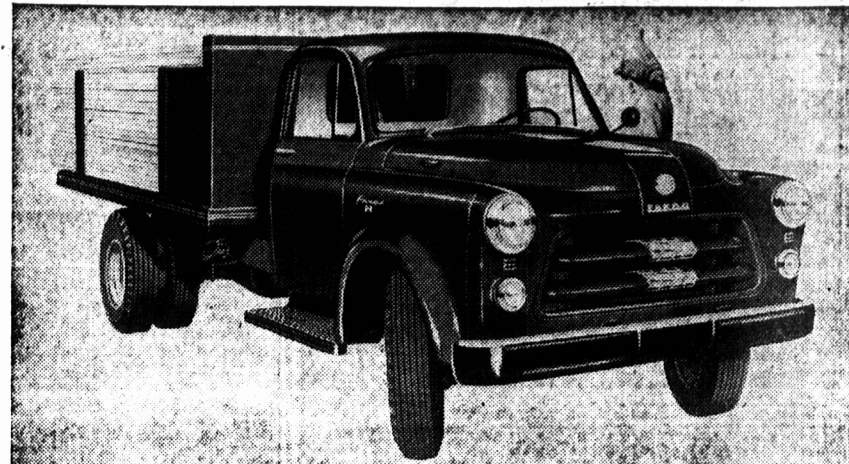
Her many friends in Bloomfield regret to hear of Mrs. Frank Gal-lant's illness at her home in Wood-stock. All hope she will soon be well again.

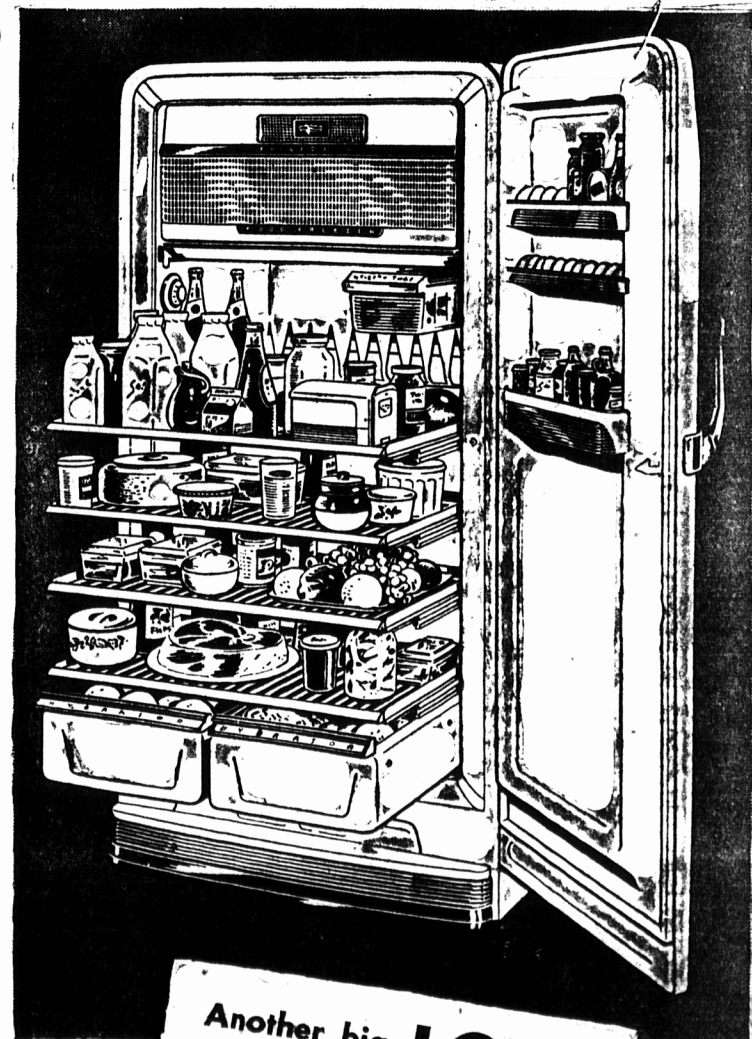
