Great Lakes Co. Profits Down

TORONTO (CP)—Great Lakes Paper Co. Ltd. had net profit in 1957 of \$2,162,292 or \$1.70 a share compared with \$3,046,497 or \$2.44 a share in 1956, it was announced Friday.

Sales increased eight per cent to a record of \$28,684,000. C. J. W. Fox, president, attributed the lower net profit to the discount on the United States dollar, and higher depreciation and interest charges.

Major expansion of mill facilities at Fort William now is approaching completion, the report said.

No. 3 newsprint machine began production last July. No. 4 machine will be ready by mid-year and will raise newsprint capacity by 110,000 tons a year to 360,000 tons.

Mr. Fox said this year's newsprint shipments will be substantially above last year's due to contracts for output of the Nos. 3 and 4 machines. These contracts brought the company up to probable full capacity, but it now appeared that actual orders will fall considerably short of contract amounts.

Accordingly, it was estimated that this year's newsprint production will average 80 per cent or better of expanded capacity.
