The bidding:

 Several of the recorded bids were rather strange, but it was North's three-diamond call which was truly astounding!
 Let's analyze from the beginning.
 West's opening bid was the first peculiar action—his hand was certainly under par, even in third position. Then, East's response was best questioned; he had a better hand. But these criticisms lose point when North's bidding technique is considered! His pass over one heart could be justified on the basis of trapping, but when South showed the values for a double of one notrump, even though he had previously passed, it was inconceivable that North should not have passed for penalties!
 Perhaps North felt that by jumping in diamonds, he could arrive at some good game contract, but if this was his reasoning, it was pretty bad! If North-South could make game anywhere—what would happen to the opposing one notrump! One thing was sure: South could not even be hoping that North had what he did have, and so, if South was willing to defend against one notrump, as his double indicated, North should have been highly enthusiastic about the thing!
 South could not be blamed for falling to respond to North's jump takeout. North had not overcalled one heart, and he announced the "inability" to leave in the double of one notrump. Where, then, could North-South hope to make game?
 North actually made five-odd at diamonds, but this was not very satisfactory, considering that East-West could have held to two tricks at one notrump doubled!
