

Young Boxer Has Incredible Record

NEW YORK (AP)—In 11 months of pro fighting, Lamar Clark has won 27 fights, 26 of them by knockouts.

Incredible! This same mid-appearing heavyweight from Cedar City, Utah, flattened six opponents in one session in the fighting time of nine minutes.

The six-in-one bargain Monday night at Bingham, Utah, was the windup of the intermountain heavyweight championship. Lamar had belted out two guys at Kanab Friday and a third at Bingham Saturday, making nine in three nights.

For winning the tournament he received \$250 and a trophy.

"Couple of times I've fought for nothing," said Clark, who visited New York to appear on a television show.

Clark, 24, is a stablemate of Gene Fullmer, the former mid-weight champion. Both are managed by mink rancher Mary Jensen of West Jordan, Utah. Lamar is five-foot, 10 inches, weighs 185, and in street clothes looks like a clerk.

"Well, one of the guys Monday (the six-in-one night) knocked me down twice in the first round. . . I got up and knocked him in the second round. The others went out in the first round."

After fighting in smokers, Golden Gloves and AAU tournaments, he turned pro last Jan. 4 under Jensen. He beat John Hix in a six-round bout. Hix was the only fighter to go the limit with him.

Manager's Eye For Talent Builds World-Famous Club

LONDON (CP)—A soccer maxim and a keen eye for talent have made Matt Busby the most successful manager in post-war British football.

When the boss of Manchester United came to the Old Trafford ground in 1945, he inherited a near-bankrupt First Division club with limited resources and a bomb-damaged stadium that forced the team to play on the neighboring Manchester City field.

February came as a tragic blow to the club that was just beginning to hit peak form. Himself seriously injured in the accident, Busby now is applying himself to the task of rebuilding the United team.

PROVED SUCCESS

A record of three Football League championships, three Football Association Cup Final appearances and a league position never below ninth is the measure of Busby's success with United.

His policy at Old Trafford has incorporated a highly successful emphasis on youth, which has been copied by almost all first-class English soccer clubs. His revolutionary plan, started 13 years ago, was to sign promising 15 and 16-year-olds, farm them

out to junior leagues, and bring them up to league standard on his own reserve sides.
