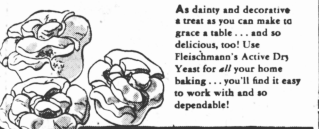

- ### Fruit Buns
- Measure into bowl 1 cup lukewarm water
 - 1 tablespoon granulated sugar
 - Sprinkle with contents of 3 envelopes Fleischmann's Active Dry Yeast
 - Let stand 10 minutes, THEN stir well.
 2. Measure, cream until soft
 - 3/4 cup butter or margarine
 - Gradually blend in 3/4 cup granulated sugar
 - 1 teaspoon salt
 - Add part of a tin, beating well after each addition.
 - 4 well-beaten eggs
 - Stir in dissolved yeast and 3 cups unbleached all-purpose flour and beat until smooth and elastic.
 - Work in additional 2 1/2 cups (about) once-sifted all-purpose flour
- Roll up as for jelly roll and cut into eight 1-inch pieces. Place in greased muffin pans and set on X in each pan with a pair of scissors. Brush buns with melted butter or margarine. Cover. Let stand in tin doubled in bulk, about 1 hour. Bake in a moderately hot oven, 375°, about 15 minutes. Yield—24 buns.

count and by reason of many representations he had received, he urged on Veterans Affairs Minister Brooks that for war veterans allowance purposes, the rate for single veterans might well be higher than fixed earlier this year. Mr. Macdonald equally appealed for an increase in the permissive earnings of those receiving war veterans allowance. This, he declared, would be a helpful step. With other M.P.'s on all sides of the Commons, Mr. Macdonald advocated bringing veterans of World War I with service in England only under the War Veterans Allowance Act. This would place these older veterans, he said, on a footing similar to veterans of World War II. An amendment to this effect, providing that the veteran concerned had served a year in England, Mr. Macdonald said, would go far to counter any opposition to the granting of war veterans allowances to those who served in Britain only in World War I.
