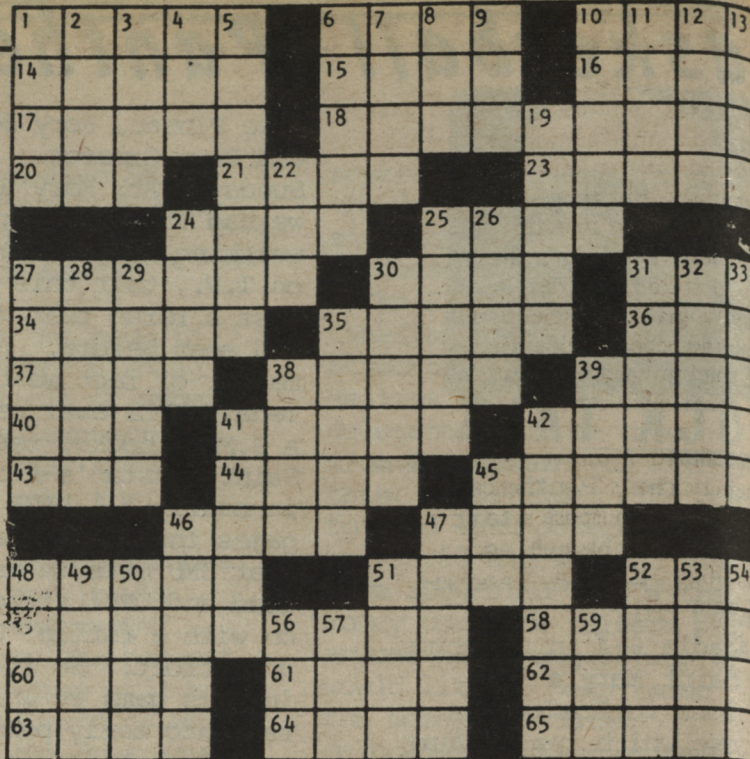

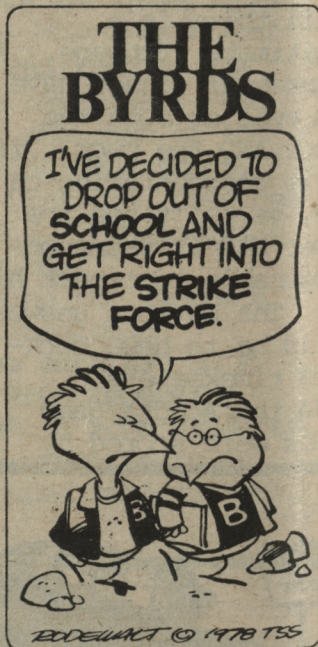
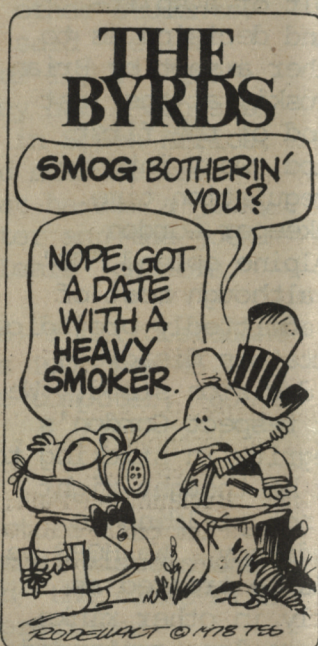

I think I will concentrate my entire article on the Canadian Armed Forces as they will be coming on campus on November 23rd. There will be an Information Session in Kelly 210 at 3.00 o'clock and this is open to any university student in any year. I think the matter that will be of most interest to you will be the Bursary Program. Some of the students involved in this program will be on hand to discuss it with you. The following information is taken from one of the pamphlets distributed by the Canadian Armed Forces:

How you can become an Officer - Each year, the Canadian Forces establishes a quota for University students, Community College or CEGEP students. The one provision of this plan is that you pursue an Officer's career. The best time to apply is in the fall of the year. However, students accepted at a University may apply during spring or summer. Candidates are selected not only on merit, but also by the course they are enrolled in.

Acceptable Course Patterns - Engineering, Sciences - General or Honours, Arts - Science; Arts - Humanities, Arts - Social Sciences, and Others - Business Administration, Commerce, Education, General Arts, International Studies, Languages, Physical Education.

Who May Apply - Students who meet the following basic requirements - Must be a Canadian citizen, must have reached the 16th birthday but not the 21st birthday on the first of January of the year of enrolment, must be enrolled or accepted in a course listed above and be available for military training during the summer months, must have demonstrated a sound academic record of achievement either in high school or university, must be able to meet prescribed minimum medical standards.
