PLUCKY PARLIAMENTARIANS.

(Ottawa Journal, independent.) A few individual members of that Parliament misbehaved, no doubt. But what sort of stuff did the great majority prove themselves to be? What sort of pluck did they show? What sort of resolute discipline did they preserve, each according to his convictions? What sort of brains did they display in the protracted conflict? The great majority of the members of the House are men of mature years who know the value of health, who know the importance of giving their constitutions fair play, yet at the call of what they held to be duty they settled down quietly to a very severe and thankless physical strain. This is true of all parties; whether government, Conservatives, Liberals or "Irreconcilables"; they all showed themselves ready to take their medicine like men. The Conservatives divided into two relays, each going on duty twelve hours out of the twenty-four. The Liberals were in three relays, eight hours each—the longer Conservative term being apparently due to the desire of the leaders to be sure of a large majority on any vote. The Third Party, a little band of half a dozen, could not arrange so systematically, but always managed to have representatives ready for emergencies. Thus divided up, the House met in a courageous and orderly manner, its most severe and protracted sessions, whether it was a matter of conscience or a matter of party, their course had much in it that was admirable. The members of each of these sections in the House were honestly striving to accomplish what each believed a desirable and justifiable end, and while the result might appear to be on the surface a purposeless and noisy talk, it was nevertheless the outcome of conscience, ability and courage in all the parties concerned.

And the debate was no mere gabble. It was a brainy and gallant contest, as full of cleverness as of courage. The pages of history are in parts more interesting reading than any work of fiction, and a careful study of the whole report of the proceedings would be a pretty liberal education to many people. It is certainly a pity to see that the time of members and the public money was, so far as progress with public business is concerned, wasted, but in so far as the character of Parliament is concerned there was much in the proceedings of last week which the people can afford to be proud of, as well as much which they must deplore.

TWO LIVE TOPICS.

The Telegraph Service and the Electric Road Bill.

Sir,—During the past five years I have had, perhaps, as much business experience with the Telegraph Company as any business man in the Province, and involving at times important transactions and covering many contracts of large values for business in continental countries, and I must say that I have never found anything else than perfect satisfaction and the most careful attention on the part of the Company.

I have never found but one error, and that was in the case of a Copthagen contract, and the mistake was afterwards traced to some forwarding office on the other side of the water, and over which the Anglo-American had no control. The conditions of the Company may be objectionable, but I have never yet known a single case where those conditions affected the interests of the sender in the delivery of his message.

If Mr. Editor of the Guardian will show me any way of agitating for a reduction in the rates charged or the procuring of a night service at half a day for only sleep and prayer, and stop the ferry, I will be glad to do so, and I will be glad to see you in the other provinces and in the United States. I will be with him as far as I can possibly go, but on the question of any complaints against the management here or of a satisfactory nature of the service rendered by the company in general I must vote against him.

As to the electric road bill I have no doubt that if the City Council adhere to their present position and withhold the privilege of a Sunday service they will grant city franchise which will deprive the citizens of one half of its benefits.

A BIG INCREASE.

Remarkable Expansion of the Anglo-Canadian Trade. LONDON, April 15.—The remarkable expansion of the Anglo-Canadian trade is shown by the imports from Canada, increased by 71 per cent. during March and 90 per cent. for the quarter of the year. Ozen increased £50,000 in the quarter; sheep, £4,000; wheat, £9,000; flour, £70,000; bacon, £14,000; ham, £8,000; butter, £3,400; cheese, £80,000; fish, £55,000; and wool, £51,000. Eggs alone declined £1,400.

The exports to Canada increased 7 per cent. during March and 12 per cent. for the three months.
