English Carpet Plant Will Locate In Truro

HALIFAX (CP)—Industrial Estates Ltd., Nova Scotia Crown corporation set up to assist secondary industry, will build a plant in Truro at a cost of about \$300,000 for Crossley Carpets (Canada) Limited. The firm, a subsidiary of John Crossley and Sons Ltd., Halifax, N.S., has announced it will establish a carpet manufacturing plant in Truro employing 100 persons. It is expected to be in production within 12 months. IEL will lease the proposed 35,000-square-foot plant to the company. An unofficial estimate of the entire cost of the project is about \$1,000,000, including equipment. The parent company, suppliers of more than half the British rugs and carpets sold in Canada, has been negotiating with IEL since November. IEL general manager R. W. Manuge said here Monday all

most all of the plant's 100 employees, about half of which will be men, would be Nova Scotians. He said Crossley had informed IEL "there is every prospect it will be able to purchase its main raw materials in Nova Scotia, for instance, woolen pile yarn and cotton backing yarn." Stanfields Ltd., a woolen manufacturing firm, and Federal Products Ltd., a textile plant, are currently located in Truro. An IEL statement says the company's decision to locate in Truro was based on the fact the town is textile orientated, has a record of labor stability and facilities for service and repair of machinery. The plant, which will produce a full line of carpeting for sale across Canada, initially will get its yarn from England. An alternative to obtaining the raw material from other Nova Scotia firms later is the expansion

British Gov't Is Planning New Trade Deals With Reds

LONDON (AP)—The British government, plagued by export difficulties and high unemployment, is quietly setting the stage for important new business deals with Russia and Red China. The board of trade has authorized the South Durham Steel and Iron Company it is free to sell oil pipe to the Russians. The \$225,000,000 Middleborough firm has been losing money lately. It hopes to pick up orders for pipeline equipment which West German companies have had in cancel as a result of a government embargo. Britain's refusal to join in a general Atlantic Alliance embargo of steel pipe sales to Russia has been criticized in Bonn and Washington.

The British cabinet is also considering a Moscow offer to sell Britain up to 2,000,000 tons of Soviet oil a year. As bail, the Russians have indicated they will place orders with the hard-pressed British shipbuilding industry. EXPORT OR DIE "This country must export or die," one senior authority said. "We are traditionally a trading nation and cannot exist in self-sufficiency as the United States could do. We would do business with the devil provided he pays." British government ministers began a round of talks with Lin Hsue-shang, Communist China's visiting deputy minister for foreign trade.

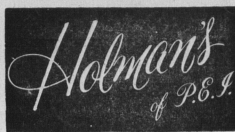
MOSCOW (AP)—The Soviet government has protested again

to the United States about pipeline sales. The Russians, in a complaint made public Saturday, said the United States is exerting pressure on other countries to refuse to sell the Soviet Union pipe for oil and gas lines. The Soviet Union urgently wants large-diameter pipe to complete major oil and gas pipelines to Poland, Czechoslovakia, Hungary and East Germany. The United States has embargoed sale of large pipe—over 19 inches in diameter—to the Soviet Union and has asked its Atlantic allies and several other countries, notably Japan, to halt sales to the Soviet Union.
