medical plan

It is brought to the attention of all students that, with the switch to Blue Cross Medical Coverage, new procedures are in effect. It will no longer be necessary to go to the Student Union office with paid receipts and then await the return of a cheque. A card will be supplied to each person who is insured and this card should be presented to the drugstore along with your prescription. A charge of \$1.00 for each prescription will be charged by the druggist...that's all no fuss - no delay and no bother. Those purchasing outside the Maritimes may have to pay the charge and then submit the receipt to Blue Cross who will then remit direct to the student.

Also...as you are aware, fees were collected from everyone at registration. Those who are already covered by their own or their

parents plan may receive a rebate PROVIDED that they apply at the Student Union office within the next week. Students should also note that coverage at the same low rate is available for a spouse or dependant children. Anyone interested in this additional coverage should also contact the Student Union within the next week.
