

A Word to Mothers.

Just a word to mothers. Have you daughters? If you have, does not every day's experience, as recorded in the daily papers, in regard to the temptations and dangers, that tempt young girls, appear to you in the most solemn and impressive manner to keep a close and more tender watch over those dear girls of youth? Keep them so by separating them as far as possible from the many evil influences that beset them. If they must go out in the evening, see to it that they do so only under proper guardianship. Be more like the mothers of France in that particular. Do not admit them to stay in the park or public squares, or promenade the park or streets with no other protection than their own innocence. This is a time when such strolls and such promenades are always fraught with mischief. The girl may escape all the snares designing men may lay for entrapping them and then again they may not. Full of life and fond of fun, they are apt to be led astray without the slightest intention on their part of doing anything wrong. How many mothers are there to-day lamenting their worse than folly—these almost criminal neglect—in permitting their girls to take evening walks with perhaps no other companions than girls of the own age. When away from their loving guardianship of their parents and the influences of home they are apt to forget how narrow is the space separates them from danger and degradation. Newark has recently furnished a number of startling warnings, which should be taken home to the heart of every mother. If you will keep them safe you must not hesitate to throw around them not merely the sacred influences of your home, but you must have these influences accompany them everywhere.

Selecting Heifers.

Raising heifers sounds well in theory but breeding cattle is a separate art from the dairying, and unless followed with great judgment is a losing business, as not every heifer raised becomes a first-class milk cow. The best plan is to buy heifers heavy with their first calves—called "springers"—and in this there is much more room for judgment and skill in making these selections than most men are willing to admit. The mistake usually made is in being misled by a fancy for certain shapes, colors and fashionable points, to the neglect of others relating immediately to the usefulness of the matured cow.

The first point to consider is, that the heifer is strong, with a deep flank, indicating constitutional vigor; then see that her teats are large and set wide apart. Viewing from behind, the twist should be open and wide, with her rudimentary udder well displayed and teats far apart. As secondary and fancy points, a slim neck, and long head with small horns, are good features. Above all things, avoid these heifers that show very little rudimentary teats or these with large ones set close together. Such a heifer never can make a first-class cow. There are enough risks to run before securing a good one, without starting out with those that never can improve. Even the best of pedigrees cannot make a good cow out of a heifer with a deformed udder. Those who have studied Guenon's method, while they do not rely upon it to the exclusion of other points, find it a great aid, and feel that they cannot ignore the escutcheon.

A Cow with a Steel Rib.

Last August Jacob Gothold, of Narrowsburgh, Sullivan county, Conn. noticing a swelling on his cow's right side. It grew bigger and bigger, but the cow didn't seem to mind it. She ate just as well, kept just as fat, and gave her full supply of milk of just as good qualities as ever. But if the swelling didn't worry the cow it did worry her owner, and he made up his mind to see what there was in it. So he made a slight incision on the top of the swelling, and the end of what seemed to be a piece of wire popped out of the cut. Gothold got hold of it and began to pull. He pulled the rib of an umbrella two feet long out of the cow's side. Nobody attempted to explain how the umbrella rib got among the cow's ribs, but the cow evidently felt the loss of it. She lost her appetite, grew thin, and ceased giving down her milk. Nothing that was done for her would satisfy her for the loss of her umbrella rib, and she kept on pining away until she died.
