It is pleasing to note the cooperation which is being shown between outgoing Premier Shaw and incoming Premier Campbell in dealing with pressing matters of governmental concern at this time.

Premier Shaw, indeed, has gone so far as to consult his successor as to the timing of his visit to the Lieutenant Governor to tender his resignation.

In the meantime, and in response, apparently, to Premier Shaw's urging that he make known his intentions in the matter, Mr. Campbell has announced that he has requested that departmental officials continue the payment of the \$25 monthly increase to all old age pensioners in the province.

It is true that he lauded federal Health Minister MacEachen's objectives under the Canada Assistance Plan when the provincial campaign was on, and actually campaigned in support of the federal Liberal candidates last November when they denounced the proposed flat \$25 old age pension boost as a Tory election bribe.

We are hoping, too, that the Premier-elect will see much more in the Shaw government's industrial expansion program than was evident from his criticism at the last legislative session, and that here, again, he will take no bones about adopting sound Tory policies when he feels

Parliament may well consider, when it gets the chance, that the three services are different in their demands and that increased specialization in each of them makes it less likely than ever than they can be made interchangeable.

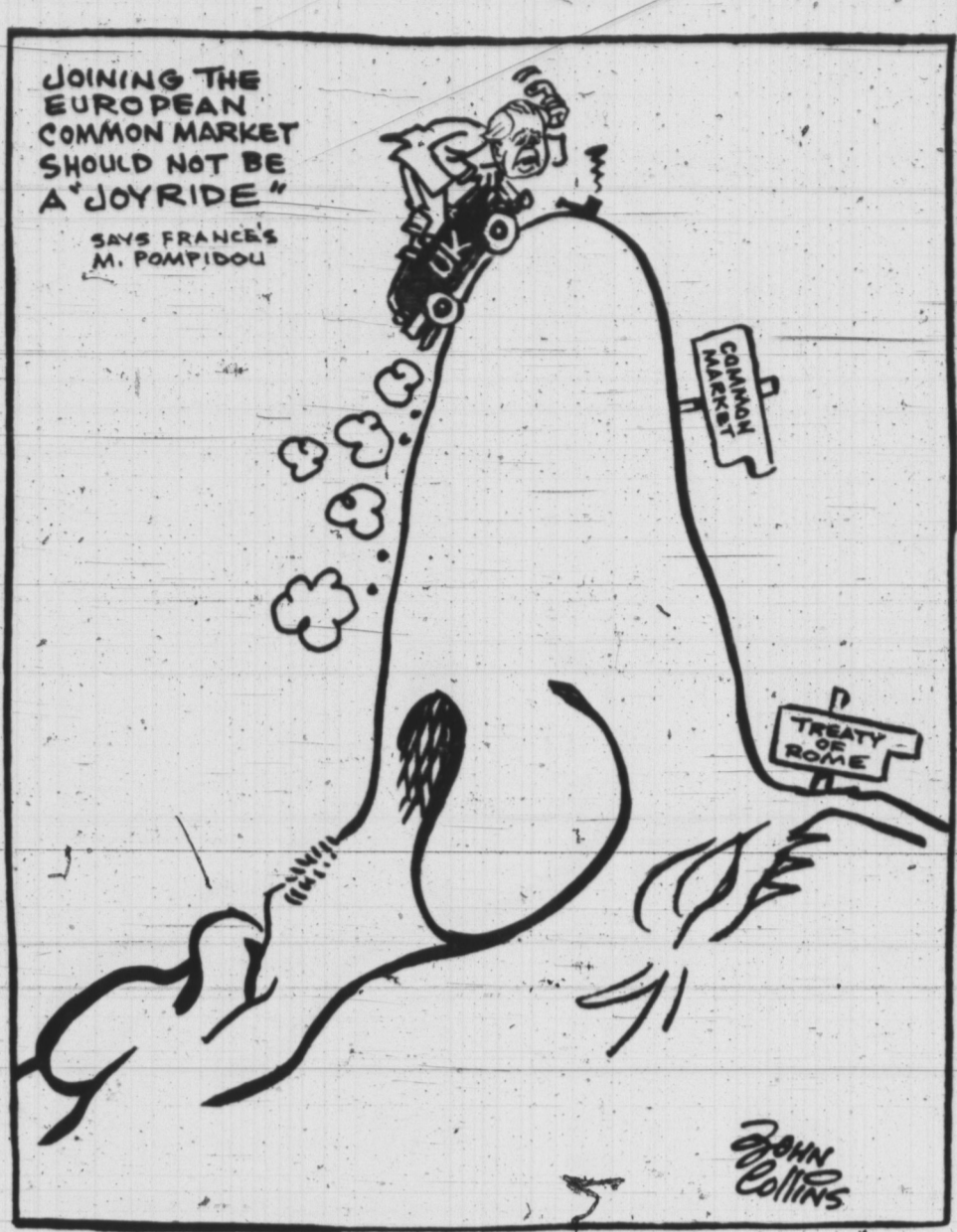
Couldn't Take It

Mosquito Repellents

The best protection against mosquitoes is to destroy the insect. This is not always practical and the only alternative is the use of repellents that are sprayed on the clothing or rubbed into the skin.

Modern repellents are good but must be reapplied every few hours. They do not deteriorate on the skin or lose effectiveness when diluted with sweat, carbon dioxide, or water.

Why are some persons more prone than others to be bitten? Moisture, heat, and carbon dioxide play a role but other anatomical factors such as glandular secretions, certain proteins in or on the skin, and fatty substances in the oils of the skin also are suspected.

IODINE RASH
W. P. writes: "What does the rash due to iodine sensitivity look like?"
