Group Capt. Anderson was born in Winnipeg in July 1915. He joined the RCAF in July 1937 after graduating from the University of Western Ontario with a Bachelor of Arts degree.

After pilot training at RCAF Station Trenton, Ont., he graduated with an army co-operation squadron and as an instructor with the army co-operation school until 1940.

During the Second World War Group Capt. Anderson was chief instructor at a number of flying training schools and commanding officer of stations at North Battleford, Sask., and Hazelton, B.C. He graduated with special distinction from the Empire Central Flying School, England, in 1945 and then returned to Canada as a staff officer with four training commands at Calgary, Alberta.
