TORONTO (CP) — Base metals and western oils were up about 1/2 of a point on index white goods closed with a 1/2 gain on the stock market Tuesday.
Golds managed to squeeze out an index gain but advanced were small. Campbell Red Lake was one of the bigger losers, down 15 cents in early trading, but it closed off five at \$8.35.

Headway was the heaviest issue traded, adding 11 cents to 71 on 177,000-share turnover. New Mylmaque was another active issue, trading 138,500 shares following an underwriting. It lost 1 cent at 19.
Western oils closed generally higher with Bailey Selburn a big winner, up 55 cents at \$8.55. Fargo, North Canadian and Consolidated Mic Mac were other winners.

NEW YORK (AP) — The stock market Tuesday climbed to its fifth straight yearly high. Trading was the second heaviest of 1958.

The ticker tape was late briefly at the opening. Wall Streeters said that both technical considerations and optimism concerning a business upturn were factors in the rise.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks rose 80 cents to \$169.70, with industrials up \$1.20, rails up \$1.10 and utilities unchanged.

Among Canadian issues on the New York exchange, Hudson Bay Mining gained 1/2, Aluminium Ltd. 3/4, Canadian Pacific 1/2 and Distillers-Seagrams and Walker-Gooderham 1/2 each.

MONTREAL (CP) — The Montreal and Canadian stock markets advanced again Tuesday in moderate turnover.

Newsprints set the pace with International Paper gaining 3/4 at a new high of 94 and Price Brothers 2 1/2 at 40 1/2 in light turnover after touching 41 during the day.

Refining oils were in demand and gained in a one-point range. Aluminium led the base metals with a gain of 1/2 at 27 1/2 in active trading.

Steels were a weak spot in the broad push. Dominion Foundries slipped 1/2 to 29.

Speculative stocks showed the more action in the mines and oils section and were mixed generally in a five-cent range.

The producers were generally on the upside. Steep Rock rose 1/2 cents to 9.15 and Home Oil 1/4 of a point to 16 1/2.

The exchanges' closing averages show banks up 1.16 at a new high of 50.21, utilities off 4.4 at 139.8, industrials up 2.6 at a new high of 243.2, combined up 1.6 at a new high of 212.1, papers up
