Report Nehru Warns Against Formosa Invasion. NEW DELHI, India (AP)—An informed source said Friday Prime Minister Nehru advised Communist China that peaceful negotiation and not bloody invasion was the method Nehru expected the Reds to use in their efforts to gain Formosa.
