## Twin Calves Are Born At Fair

A pair of twin calves were dropped Sunday night in the Edison B. Mutch stables at the Exhibition grounds.

The youngsters carry in their blood veins some of the very best blood in the Jersey world. Their mother is Rivernorth Lily Beacon. She is sired by Edgela Beacon Jester Standard, a grand champion at the Royal Winter Fair as well as at Charlottetown for Mr. Mutch in past years, and showing again today.

The maternal grandmother of the twins is Rivernorth Jester's Darling, a cow in Mr. Mutch's herd that has a record of 728 lbs of fat in 305 days. The maternal grandsire of the newcomers to the Jersey world is Rivernorth Jester's Standard Dreamer, another grand champion at the Royal for Mr. Mutch, and a consistent winner in big Jersey shows in the states since Mr. Mutch sold him several years ago.

The youngsters themselves are as yet unnamed.

## Few More Cases Of Late Blight

The moist conditions that covered most areas during the first few days of August resulted in a few more cases of late blight Prince Edward Island and initiated the first infection on the North Mountain of Kings County, Nova Scotia. Further development of the disease has been retarded by the drier air that moved in on the 8th of the month, states the weekly potato bulletin issued by the Science Service Laboratory. Ideal conditions for the application of fungicides now prevail, and growers should take advantage of this period to protect their fields in case blight favourable weather should return.

Aphids and flea beetles are still increasing very slowly but with proper weather conditions they can build up rapidly. Even if the aphid population is low it would be wise to add Malathion to the spray to prevent this rapid increase.
