CROP REPORT

Below will be found a brief synopsis of telegraphic reports received at the Head Office of the Bank of Montreal from its Branches. Our Managers have knowledge of each local situation and are in touch with crop conditions in all sections of the districts mentioned.

GENERAL

Harvesting of the prairie wheat crop is progressing favourably in Saskatchewan and Alberta and is well advanced in Manitoba, although rains have further delayed operations. Early threshing returns indicate that wheat yields will be slightly better than anticipated.

PRAIRIE PROVINCES

ALBERTA—Cutting is general and good harvest prevails. Early reports from southern Alberta indicate yields to be higher than anticipated, with widely varying grades. Elsewhere crops are ripe and yields average to slightly below average.

PROVINCE OF QUEBEC

EASTERN TOWNSHIPS AND OTTAWA VALLEY—Harvesting of grain is well under way and while some damage from lodging is reported, a satisfactory yield is indicated.

PROVINCE OF ONTARIO

Harvesting operations have been delayed slightly by intermittent showers, but the moisture has been beneficial for late crops.

of good quality. Cutting of spring grains is nearing completion with average yields and satisfactory quality. The second cutting of alfalfa is comparatively light. Sugar beets, turnips and mangolds continue good.

MARITIME PROVINCES

Grains are ripening rapidly but some deterioration is noted owing to lack of moisture. Harvesting of the earlier varieties is under way and a satisfactory yield is indicated.

PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA

Hot, dry weather continues throughout the province. Grain is under way and is expected to yield 90 per cent of average. A good second crop of alfalfa has been cut under ideal conditions.

WINNIPEG, Aug. 30 (CP)

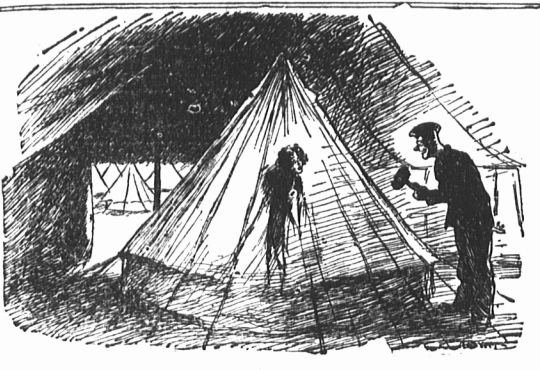
