Great George St.

Strange But True

The habit of walking about while asleep is one of the most curious of all the phenomena of the nervous system.

The somnambulist state, we are told, is simply an exaggerated dream. The intellectual faculties are dormant yet parts of the brain are more active than usual.

While in this state persons have been known to accomplish feats which would be impossible for them in their normal everyday life.

For example, let's take the case of Cartell, who was found one night asleep in the act of translating from a dictionary. When his candle was snuffed out, he went about the house looking for another light. Those who talked with him at such times were amazed that he gave rational answers to all their questions, but strange to say he appeared to hear nothing or see anyone.

The "Encyclopaedia Methodique" has a remarkable story related by the Archbishop of Bordeaux. It was concerning a young priest at the Catholic seminary, who used to get up in his sleep and write sermons. When he'd finished writing a page, he would read it aloud and make corrections. That this writing was accomplished by mental action and not by sight may be proved by the following test. After he had written a page requiring correction, a sheet of blank paper was substituted for the original and on that he made the corrections in exactly the same place which they would have occupied on the original manuscript.

Always there is the little flock of shepherds raised up in time of great crisis to lead the masses that would become scattered or perish for the lack of leadership.

At the Gettysburg dedication an address was given in the evening by Mr. Charles Anderson, in a church. The audience arose as Lincoln entered the building. An old man, shabbily followed the president up the aisle; and when reaching the seat reserved for Lincoln started to go in with him. Governor Todd, who escorted the president, put a restraining hand on the old man's shoulder and said, "You can't go in there."

Lincoln turned to the governor and observed, "Yes, governor, that's my man," and placing his arm about the old man, led him into the pew. It was the man who entered the battle of Gettysburg and had fought independently all that eventful day, believe it or not!
