## Mrs. Eisenhower Doing Fine

**WASHINGTON (AP)**—Mrs. Dwight D. Eisenhower was reported "doing fine" Tuesday after surgery at Walter Reed Hospital, where the president visited her late in the afternoon.

James C. Hagerly, White House press secretary, said the doctors had authorized him to report: "Mrs. Eisenhower's post-operative condition is fine and she has been sleeping most of the afternoon."

The precise nature of the operation, which required two hours, and was performed by an army gynaecologist Tuesday morning, was not announced.

However, Hagerly said it was "heaven" which means there was no malignant or cancerous condition. He also said there was no tumor.
