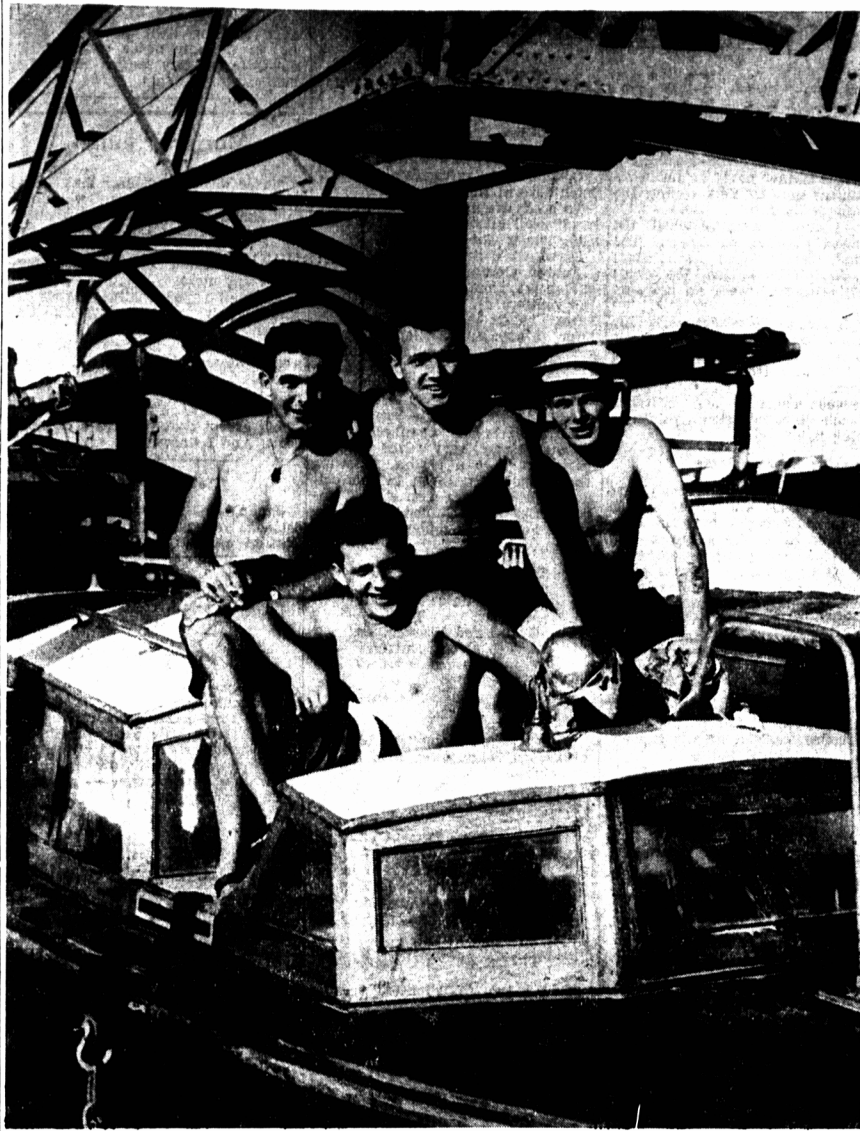


## St. Louis Sailor On Training Cruise
