Manufacturers Life Elects J. H. Lithgow, President



James Hector Lithgow, who joined the Manufacturers Life in 1908 as a \$5.00 a week clerk in its Actuarial Department, was elected President of the Company at a Board of Directors Meeting on December 13. The appointment of Mr. Lithgow fills the vacancy caused by the death on November 25 of the late President, Melville Ross Gooderham. Born in Bobaygeon, Ontario in 1890, the son of James and Mary (Long) Lithgow, he was educated in local public and high schools and at Trinity College School, in Port Hope, Ontario. At the age of 17 he began his career with the Manufacturers Life in Toronto and 11 years later, in 1919 was appointed Assistant Actuary. During this time he served two years overseas with the Canadian Field Artillery during World War I. Appointments came in regular succession after his return to civilian life. In 1924 he was appointed Actuary, in 1930 Assistant General Manager and Actuary, in 1931 General Manager and Actuary, in 1935 member of the Board of Directors in 1936 and eight years later was elected Vice-President and General Manager.
