SYDNEY (CP) - James W. Fraser, 59, managing director of H. H. Marshall Ltd., Halifax news and magazine distributors, died suddenly here Monday. He was born in Boston but lived as a boy and young man in Prince Edward Island, where he taught school at Eldon. He joined the Marshall firm in 1921 after serving with the army in Europe in the First World War. The funeral will be held in Halifax Thursday.
