

PUSHES BUTTON FOR SCRANTON

Private Investment Is Heavy In N.S. Economic Expansion

NEW YORK (CP) — V. M. Knight, Nova Scotia deputy minister of trade and industry, said Tuesday more than \$100,000,000 is being invested in his province's industrial and commercial expansion program by private interests.

Knight told a luncheon meeting of the U.S. Commerce and Industry Association the flow of new investments "should once and for all dispel the myth Nova Scotia is solely the land of the lobster and the idyllic fishing village."

Knight reported manufacturing tops fishing at least eight-fold and Nova Scotia factory shipments now are running at the rate of \$42,000,000 a month, 12 per cent more than the 1963 rate.

As for new construction, he said the province is outstripping the rest of Canada on a per capita basis.

Knight listed several projects planned or nearing completion in which Canadian, American and European interests have invested heavily.

They are:

- The \$35,000,000 Cornwallis centre complex of office buildings, shopping centre and hotels which soon will be built by British interests in downtown Halifax.
- REFINERY OPENS MONDAY
- The \$14,000,000 Texaco refinery, which opens next Monday and will process Venezuelan crude for the Maritime provinces market. Up to now refined oil had come from Texaco facilities in Montreal.
- The Lamsberg Sea Products Ltd. plant which opens June 24. A \$9,000,000 Canadian facility, it will be the largest fish processing plant in North America, covering 5½ acres under a single roof.
- The world's first commercial heavy water plant, a \$40,000,000 venture, to be financed by Deuterium Corp., New York City, and Industrial Estates Ltd., Nova Scotia's industry-getting agency. Construction is planned to start in the fall.
- The \$1,300,000 Reynolds Metals Plant, the only aluminum plant in Canada, which will start operations this summer.
- The \$1,000,000 carpet mill owned jointly by Fieldcrest Mills of North Carolina and Crossley Carpets of the United Kingdom, now nearing completion.
- Sweden's A. B. Volvo auto firm now celebrating its first year of operation in Halifax planning for a new 250,000 square foot assembly plant.
- Volvo, first European firm to produce autos in North America, has more than doubled its original sales target in the first year.
- Knight said Industrial Estates Ltd. offers incoming companies many incentives including aid in constructing and leasing facilities in modern industrial parks.

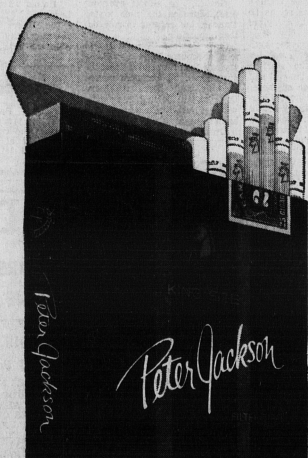
