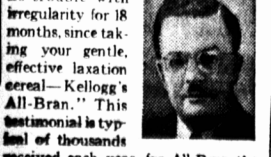
Gray Fox ran a little faster to get a little ahead of that Dog. He headed straight for that big tree.

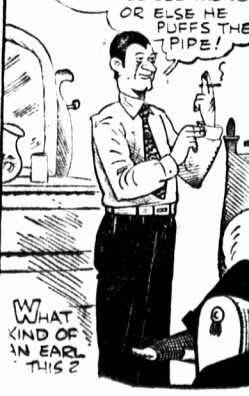

CONTRACT BRIDGE

ENTIRELY TOO many bridge slogans have gained popularity. Most of them are worse than useless; they are downright dangerous.

South won the necessary nine tricks at his very remarkable heart contract, but he couldn't be too smug about that in view of the game that would have been so easy at spades (or even at no-trump or diamonds).

The huge flaw in the bidding was, of course, South's vacuous rebid of three hearts. This rebid was the reflection of South's philosophy that he could not make a strong raise of partner's suit because there was no assurance that North had a five-card or longer suit and because South himself did not have four-card support.

There were two glaring defects in South's three-heart rebid. First, the heart suit itself was not strong enough; second (and more important) this jump rebid of the original suit is not even a force.

If South had irrepressible scruples against a huge spade raise, he might at least have jumped to three no-trump or manufactured a forcing bid of three diamonds.

Let's look at a deal: South dealer. Both sides vulnerable.

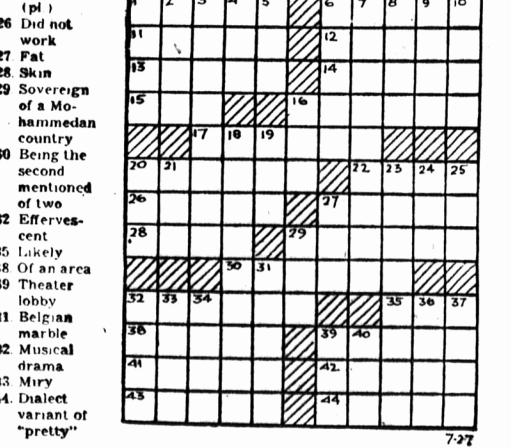
