

Peugeot Plant For Quebec In Final Discussion

PARIS (Reuters) — Negotiations for setting up a French car assembly plant in Canada are in the final and decisive phase, a spokesman of Peugeot car manufacturers said here.

"The final draft of a 15-page contract now is under way," he said. "The contract which will be signed by Peugeot is due for dispatch to Quebec in the next week or 10 days."

The contract will then be submitted for the approval and signature of Gerard Filion, head of Quebec's General Investment Corporation which will set up the \$3,500,000 plant for the assembly of Peugeot and Renault cars.

A similar contract is concurrently being negotiated with Renault whose spokesman said: "We expect an announcement in the next day or so."

Quebec Premier Jean Lesage is to make a statement in connection with the proposed Renault - Peugeot car assembly plant in Quebec today, a spokes-

(Continued from page nine) centers for black ducks — the Harvey Moore Sanctuary at Milltown Cross and Black Pond Sanctuary a few miles east of Souris. There was the off chance that they might be right and this columnist is one who believes in what his own eyes tell him when it comes to game birds and animals. Moore's Sanctuary held one hundred and fifty blacks — give or take a half dozen either way — with an approximate score of other species such as teal and Ring-necked ducks. In normal seasons its black duck population crowded the one thousand mark. Eastern Kings is practically devoid of black ducks — 24 at Black Pond Sanctuary and 4 at South Lake. Diligent Pond did not show duck of any species but 9 wild geese were resting on the sandbar that juts out on its southern border. Black Pond and South Lake normally would sport an occupants who were returning

from building their duck blind blacks between them. East Lake was reported to harbour a grand total of eight blacks and fifty odd teal.

The ducks at Black Pond Sanctuary ... what a misnomer to call it a sanctuary ... had smelted gun powder and heard the rattle of chilled steel this season already. Sweeping Inquiry Launched Into Canadian Tax System

OTTAWA (CP)—An inquiry that could lead to sweeping changes in the Canadian tax system was formally launched by the federal-provincial conference.

Prime Minister Pearson described it as a historic step, leading mainly to a new tax arrangement starting in the centennial of 1967.

He reported premiers Lesage of Quebec and Roberts of Ontario hailed the study in the closed conference as "a very encouraging and positive step forward" in financial relations between the provinces and Ottawa.

Following are the main terms of reference for the study, to be carried out by early 1966 by a committee of federal and provincial ministers and their advisers.

Probable federal-provincial municipal spending trends for 1967-72, "taking into account the broad priorities likely to be accorded by governments to expenditures on major programs that will complete for available funds."

"The problems involved in financing these expenditures and their relationship to the economic circumstances to be expected, the probable levels of costs of public services and facilities, and the prospective levels of government debt."

The general policy for shared-cost programs in 1967-72.

"The tax fields that should be used exclusively by the federal government and by the provinces and municipalities, and the fields in which joint occupancy is desirable."

Arrangements for jointly-occupied tax fields.

Equalization arrangements for 1967-72, and the relation of equalization payments "to the fiscal requirements and fiscal capacities of the provinces."

Future inter-governmental liaison on fiscal and economic matters.

The study was conceived at the Quebec City conference last spring. The terms of reference were drawn up Tuesday by the finance ministers of the 11 governments and were approved unanimously Wednesday by the plenary conference.
