But at the rate the 'Spos are going, they'll probably be the Wichita Eagles before long, and at the rate Bouchard is screwing up Quebec, even the Montreal

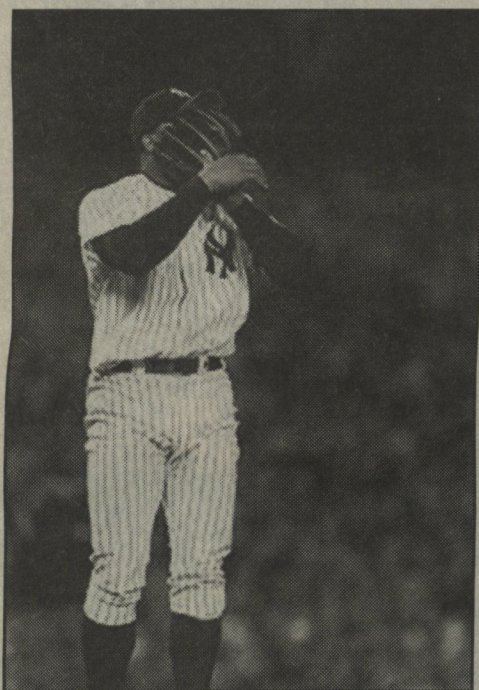
games to weed out the weak teams early on so the playoffs don't last into August like the NHL.

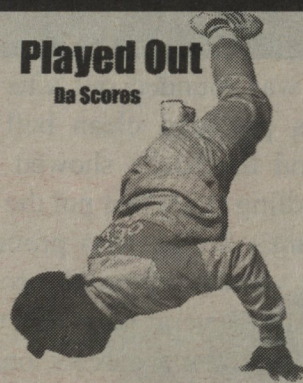
