

clay road at Tryon totalling over 20 birds (B&RH), 8 in deep snow at Mermaid on Jan. 19 (JDM); **Ruffed Grouse** - 1 huddled at roadside in Southampton in late Dec. & 1 budding pin cherries at Donagh on Jan. 5 (JDM); **Marbled Godwit** - 1 on Souris River on Dec. 25 (KMck) [Editor's note: this is the first winter sighting that we know of on record for PEI]; **Sanderling** - hung around until well into November at Robinson's Island this year (DG&GS); **Black-headed Gull** - 3 at Souris River and 2 at the Souris ferry terminal on Dec. 25 (KMck); **Bonaparte's Gull** - 12 or more at Cardigan Bay on Dec. 24 (KMck); **Iceland Gull** - 6 at Georgetown on Dec. 24 (KMck), 30 at the Souris ferry terminal and 1 at East Point on Dec. 25 (KMck); **Glaucous Gull** - 1 at the Souris ferry terminal on Dec. 25 (KMck); **Black-legged Kittiwake** - 1 immature at East Point on Dec. 25 (KMck); **Murre** - either Thick-billed or Common 1st year in open water and on shore at North Rustico National Park entrance on Jan. 6 (D&ESe); **Rock Dove** - 6 at Little Sands feeder in late Dec. & early Jan. (N&CJ); **Mourning Dove** - 1 to 3 daily at Donagh feeder in Dec. and early Jan. (JDM, RPh), up to 31 at Tryon feeder in Dec. & Jan. (B&RH); **Black Guillemot** - 1 at Georgetown on Dec. 24 (KMck), 1 at the Souris ferry terminal on Dec. 25 (KMck); **Snowy Owl** - 1 at Robinson's Island 3rd week of Dec. (DG&GS); **Belted Kingfisher** - 1 at Bridgetown on Dec. 25 (KMck), 1 at Hazelbrook perched over creek on Jan. 13 (JDM); **Downy Woodpecker** - 1 occasionally at Rocky Point feeder from mid-Dec. to early Jan. (LD), 1 at Donagh feeder periodically in late Dec. & early Jan. (JDM, RPh), 1 at French Village feeder on Dec. 26 (HG); **Yellow-shafted (Northern) Flicker** - 1 at Bunbury feeder on Jan. 9-10 (R"D"T), 1 at Charlottetown suet feeder on Jan. 11 9 (SCI), 1 at New Dominion feeder on Jan. 19 (PC); **Northern Shrike** - 1 at John Archie's pond on Dec. 29 (DSe), 1 immature in Primrose on Dec. 25 (KMck); **Gray Jay** - 3 at East Point on Dec. 25 (KMck); **Blue Jay** - 6 to 15 at Donagh feeder in late Dec. & early Jan. (JDM, RPh), 5 or more at Tryon feeder in Dec. & Jan. (B&RH), 5 at French Village feeder in Dec. (HG); **American Crow** - 6 at French Village feeder in Dec. (HG); **Black-capped Chickadee** - 5 to 9 at Donagh feeder in late Dec. & early Jan. (JDM, RPh), 6 or more at Tryon feeder in Dec. & Jan. (B&RH), steady stream at French Village feeder in Dec. (HG); **Red-breasted Nuthatch** - 1 or 2 at Donagh feeder taking striped sunflower seed in late Dec. & early Jan. (RPh), 1 at Rocky Point feeder on Dec. 30 & 31 (LD); **American Robin** - 200 at Mt. Albion on Dec. 27 (R&LMacD), 50 in Rocky Point tree tops on Dec. 28 (LD), robins in Donagh in late Dec. (RPh), 5 at Little Sands feeder in late Dec. early Jan. (N&CJ), 5 in Charlottetown on Jan. 8 & 9 (SCI), 3 in Mountain Ash in Donagh on Jan. 14 (RPh, JDM), 1 in Charlottetown on Jan. 19 (EMu), 1 foraging along roadside scraped of snow in Bunbury daily in late Jan. (JDM); **Bohemian Waxwing** - see CBC reports; **Cedar Waxwing** - group at Brackley on Dec. 22 (DSe), 12 at Georgetown on Dec. 24 (KMck); **Eastern (formerly Rufous-sided) Towhee** - 1 at Stratford from at least Dec. 14 to 24 (CAC); **American Tree Sparrow** - 1 at French Village feeder on Dec. 24-26 (HG), 5 to 8 at Donagh feeder in Jan. (JDM, RPh), 2 at Rocky Point feeder from mid-Dec. to early Jan. (LD), 1 at Hardy Mill Pond feeder on Jan. 5 (MJ); **Song Sparrow** - 2 at Rocky Point feeder from mid-Dec. to early Jan. (LD); **Swamp Sparrow** - see CBC report; **White-throated Sparrow** - 2 to 3 at Rocky Point feeder from mid-Dec. to early Jan. (LD), at Little Sands feeder in late Dec. early Jan. (N&CJ); **Dark-eyed Junco** - large number at Brackley on Dec. 22 (DSe), 6 at Little Sands feeder in late Dec. early Jan. (N&CJ), 8 or more at Tryon feeder in Dec. & Jan. (B&RH), 4 to 6 at Donagh feeder in Jan. (JDM, RPh); **Snow Bunting** - 6 at East Point on Dec. 25 (KMck), 40 at Bridgetown on Dec. 25 (KMck), 2 at Tryon feeder once in Dec. (B&RH); **Rose-breasted Grosbeak** - 1 male at Little Sands feeder on Jan, 2 (N&CJ); **Common Redpoll** - very few sighting reports this winter; **Pine Siskin** - 1 at Rocky Point feeder early Jan. 1 & 2 (LD); **American Goldfinch** - numerous at Little Sands feeder in late Dec. early Jan. (N&CJ), 20+ at Tryon feeder in Dec. & Jan. (B&RH); **Evening Grosbeak** - male and female at Little Sands feeder in late Dec. early Jan. (N&CJ), 2 males and 1 female at Hardy Mill Pond feeder on Jan. 5 (MJ);
