Foresees wide use of method

The future of electric heating was outlined by G.M. McHenry, manager, residential sales department, Ontario Hydro-Electric Power Commission, in a paper presented this year.

Mr. McHenry said: "No one really knows the future of electric heating, but those of us who have been working with this development for several years are more and more confident that there is a tremendous future for electric heating in the residential market."

"We are further encouraged in this view by supporting opinions from many people in the conventional heating industry, who really have little to gain from the development of electric heating. We are also supported by the manufacturers of conventional furnace equipment, some of whom are now developing lines of electric heating equipment because they see it as a necessity to give them a full line and to protect their future markets," said Mr. McHenry.

Mr. McHenry added that it was believed that electric heating would be installed in at least a third of the homes in Ontario within the next 10 years. Also during that time it was expected to convert existing homes to electric heating at a rapid rate, said Mr. McHenry.

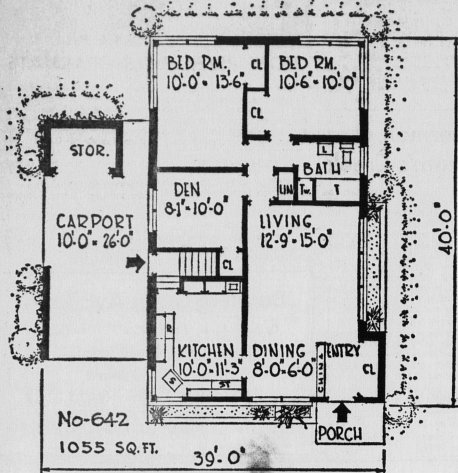

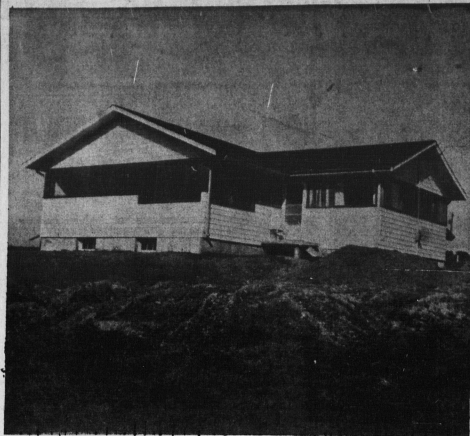

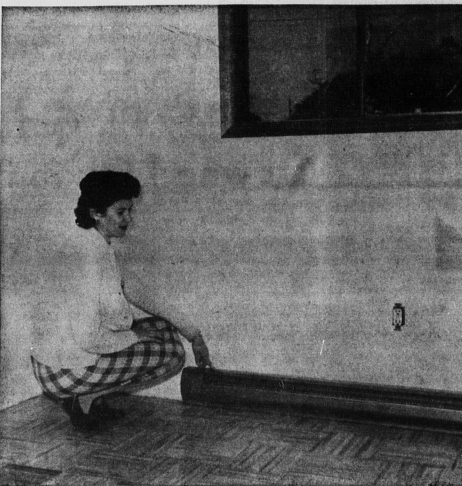


Blueprints include complete details for both BRICK VENEER and FRAME construction

OYSTER BED BRIDGE HOME recently completed is one of the first homes on the Island to dispense with a furnace. It is heated by electricity through baseboard radiators

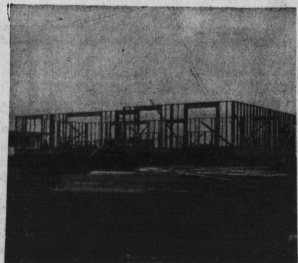

Ontario is moving rapidly in the electric heating field, both residentially and commercially. One small town in Ontario is electric heating in every home

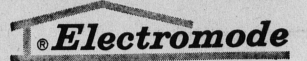
Matador takes monk's roles

with 21 other Dominican postulants in the traditional gesture of submission at the convent of Caleruega, near Burgos. He now begins a seven-year march to the priesthood.

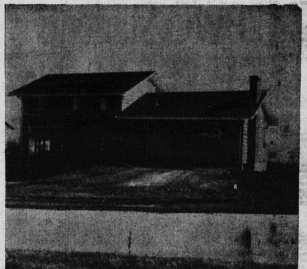
"I aspire to live eternally," said the man whose peripatetic career brought him 18 gorings, eight of them serious.

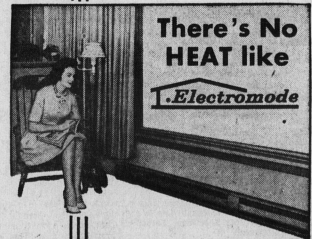
