**Perjury Charges**

TORONTO (C.P.) - Perjury charges have been laid against Ralph K. Ferris, president of the Northern Natural Gas Company, following an scandal that rocked the provinces and led to the resignations of three Ontario cabinet ministers.

Attorney - General Cass announced the charges at a press conference Tuesday after new evidence in the five-year-old controversy was uncovered by the Ontario and court proceedings against him started Monday.

Some time next month, the Ontario court will hear statements Mr. Ferris made on an original investigation in 1958 and again in 1962 when new evidence uncovered by British Columbia investigative agency has renewed inquiries into share distributions by the firm.

The investigations are proceeding when the firm, which has operations across Ontario and in Alberta and Saskatchewan, is accused of winning political favor by offering blocks of shares to officials before they were released on the open market.
