More New Cars Sold In Province

New passenger car and truck sales showed an increase in Prince Edward Island during the month of May over the corresponding period of last year. This was the only one of the ten provinces to show an increase, all others showing a decrease, with the total drop in sales amounting to 14.1 percent.

Car sales in this province showed an increase of 2.6 percent, while truck sales jumped 5.8 percent. In dollar value the like in car sales amounted to 11.6 percent and truck sales 11.2 percent.

Actual sales for May totaled 46,844 units as compared with 54,527 units in 1957. The dollar value dropped from \$163,236,000 to \$146,671,000.
