Campus

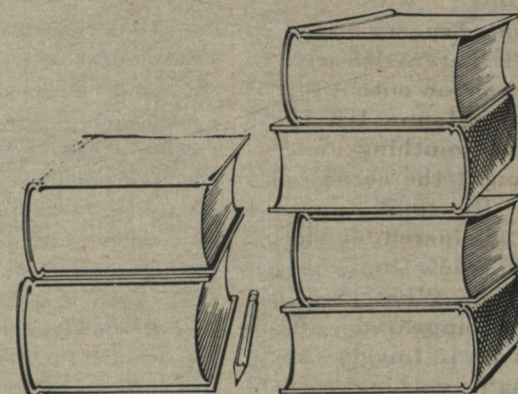
Tues. Jan. 26th
