- 1. To all Incorporated Villages
2. The Towns of Alberton, Georgetown and Montague
3. The School Districts of Souris West, Alexandra, Cross Roads, Bunbury, Southport, Central Lot 16, Linkletter, Sherbrook, West Royalty, East Royalty, Stanhope.
4. All that land within one mile of the boundary of all Towns, Villages and Parks in the Province.
5. All that land within 540 feet of the centre line of Trans-Canada Highway.
6. All that land within 540 feet of the centre line of the Highway between the Eastern Boundary of the Village of St. Eleanors and Albany Corner.
7. Land adjacent to Beaches
Regulations are now designed to control:
(1) Plans of Sub-division
(2) Location of Buildings on lot
(3) Changing the location of any building or structure
(4) Excavations
Persons intending to subdivide their property to erect or structurally alter any dwelling or other building or structure in this area are reminded that it is necessary to FIRST obtain a Permit from this Department.

NEW YORK

NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market advanced Wednesday, breaking a string of four straight daily losses. Trading was active.

The Dow Jones industrial average rose 1.84 to 796.82, closing below its best level of 798.16 when the average showed a gain of 4.18.

The New York Stock Exchange index rose \$3.33 to \$43.40. Standard and Poor's 500-stock index gained .54 at 292.2.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks gained 1.1 at 292.2 with industrials up 4, rails up 1.3 and utilities up 1.2.

Chrysler was the most active stock, up 1/4 at 30 1/2. Among Canadians traded, Alcan, Cranby Mining and Phillips C added 1/2 each.

Prices were generally higher on the American Stock Exchange. Scurry Rainbow gained 1/4 and Brazilian Light, Canadian Javelin, Fargo and Jupiter each were up 1/4.

TORONTO (CP) - Trading was active at steady prices for heavy receipts of unfinished slaughter cattle at the Ontario public stockyards Wednesday.

Replacement cattle 600: Good light stockers 27-29; good steers calves 25-33; mediums and commons 20-25. Calves 494: Choice vealers 28-30; with odd tops to 45; good 26-34; mediums 25-30; commons 21-24; boners 17-20.

Hogs 2,852: Grade A at Toronto 33.85-34.35, currently at Toronto 34.10; heavy sows 17-21.

Among the utilities, Quebec Telephone advanced 1/4 to 18 while B.C. Telephone lost one point to 60. Bell Telephone led the list of most active industrial, rising 1/4 to 45 1/2 on a turnover of 12,278 shares.

In metals, Cominco fell 1/4 to 31 1/4. Hudson Bay was off 1/4 at 65 1/2. Alcan advanced 1/4 to 27 1/2. On the industrial list, Dominion Textiles added 1/4 to 25 1/2 and CIL 1/4 to 16 1/2.

BANKS HIGHER
Banks were fractionally higher. Royal added 1/4 to 68 and Nova Scotia 1/4 to 62.

Among the senior oils, Home A and Imperial each gained 1/4 to 21 1/2 and 53 1/2, respectively. Prices were mixed in light trading on the Canadian Stock Exchange.

Alcopec fell six cents to \$1.29 and Phoenix 10 cents to \$3.20. Peace River climbed 60 cents to \$7.85.

On index, industrials advanced 45 to 143.80, utilities 1.11 to 127.16 and banks .07 to 109.36. Papers were off .55 at 107.15.
