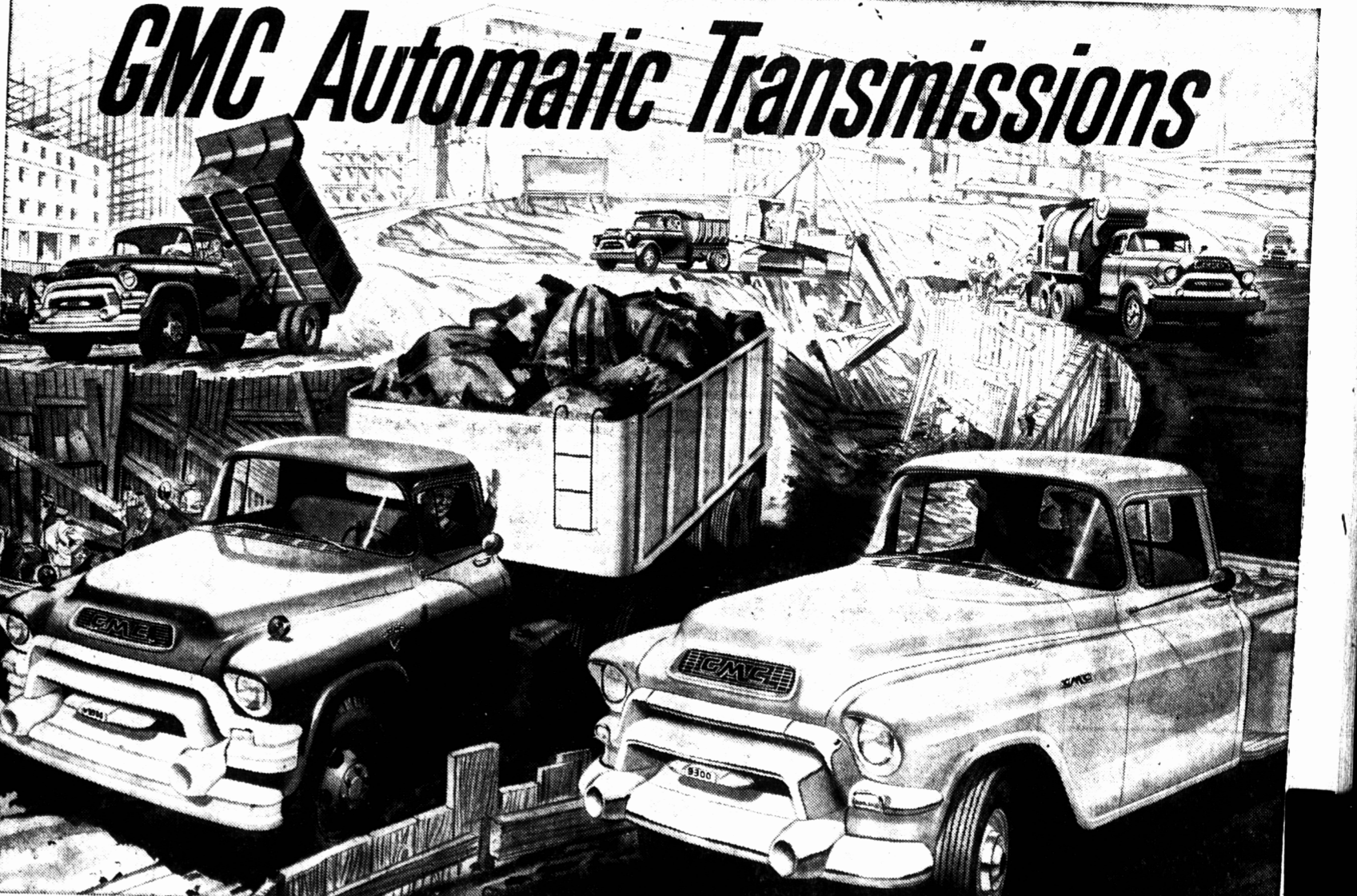
A delicious lunch was served by the hostess assisted by several ladies present.
