This year's Business-persons' Dinner is slated for March and we are in the planning stages. We would

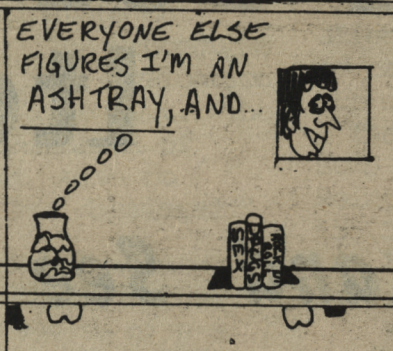
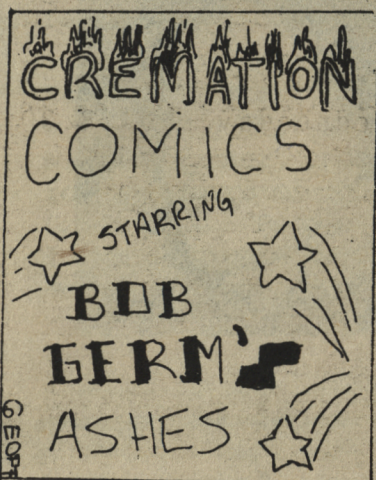
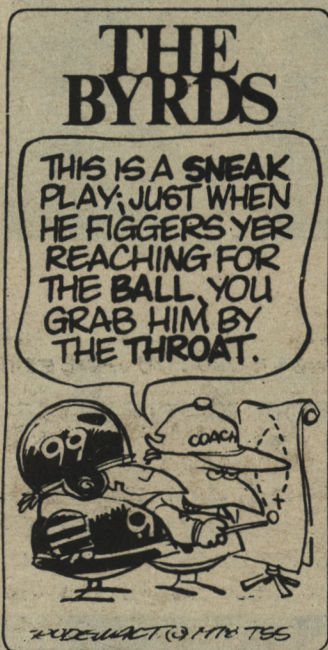
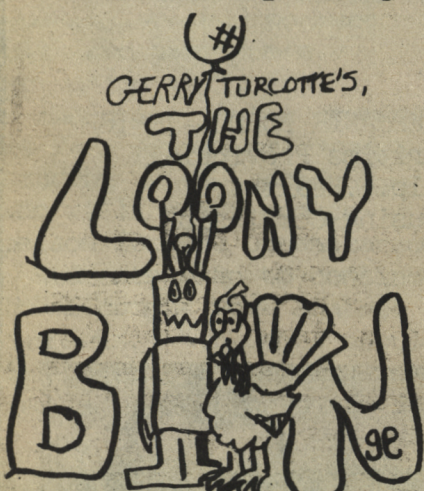
greatly appreciate it if the students could suggest possible speakers and topics. A top-notch speaker is the key to making this event a success.
