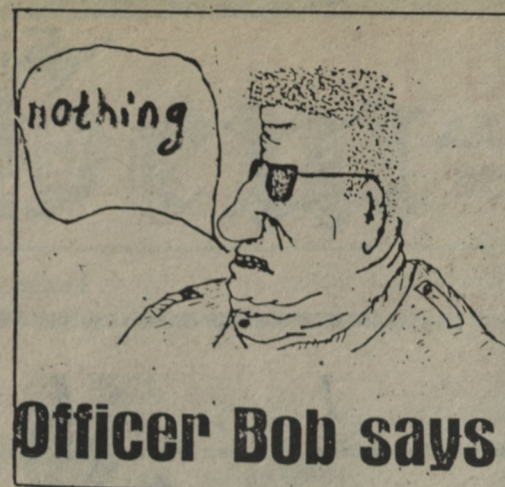

Other demonstrations included: an explanation of what Prime Numbers are, a presentation about the Math & CS Society is available, introductory Math and Computer Science courses, Math Competitions, what Math and Computer Science programs are available, and a Digital Design experiment.

Of special interest to everyone was the "Professor Doing Research", a life-sized dummy complete with simulated snoring and research books galore.

There were many interesting videos and lectures presented during the two-day event. Two videos were presented, "The World of Pure Mathematics" and "The Age of Intelligent Machines". Professor Ivan Dowling made a presentation on what Prime Numbers are, while the team of Professors Wayne Cutcliffe and Stephen Howard presented an explanation of what is involved in making a computer program. Professor Patrice Sawyer presented what a person's chances are in a lottery, while Professor Lowell Sweet gave a talk on whether or not there could possibly be a proof to Fermat's Last Theorem.

The Math and CS Society would like to thank all the professors and students who took time out of their busy schedules to make this the success it was, and, most of all, they would like to thank all the people who were interested enough to visit main floor of Memorial building to see what we had to offer.
