The Clyde in the shipbuilding trade on the Stagnation is apparently most serious. The North British Daily Mail estimates that there are at present between Glasgow and Greenock over 15,000 men out of work everyone of them willing to accept any occupation that might offer, although skilled workmen at their trades. This statement, however, only partly shows the depression. Out of the 148 building berths on the Clyde only 49 are now in use. The industry employs, in good times, from 50,000 to 60,000 men and it follows that there are 30,000 or 40,000 men not working on the Clyde who would be employed there if all the building yards were in full operation. About one third of this number, it is thought, have migrated to other shipbuilding centres in Great Britain, but the Mail thinks 15,000 is less than the number of men actually idle on the Clyde at the present time.
