3. ♠A32 ♦AKJ54 ♣7 ♦QJ83 4. ♠KQ4 ♦AKQ72 ♣A95 ♣J5
1. Four hearts. This is not a closeout bid, contrary to common conception. It is a slam try of a kind as specialized type. The jump to four hearts shows a suit practically independent of support and at the same time indicates a hand that was originally close to a forcing two bid.
