Upper St. John River Dam Pondered By U.S., Canada

B ARCH MacKENZIE 400,000 Dickey Dam on the upper St. John River in northern Maine. Interior Secretary Stewart Udall said here. But he indicated that the U.S. government will be happy if Congress approves only that project this year rather than

the entire Passamaquoddy tidal-power proposal with which it is allied.

The government is "very close to having a strong position" on the Dickey Dam project. Udall told a press conference. "The big hope for 1965 is the authorization of a dam on the St. John."

New Brunswick would receive hydro and flood-control benefits from Dickey as downstream American states will receive them when dams are completed on the Columbia River in British Columbia.

Dickey would flood some New Brunswick land.

WOULD HARNESS BAY

Udall would like to press this year for the entire Passamaquoddy concept, which features harnessing the Bay of Fundy's high tides in New Brunswick territory, and part of Maine's adjacent area.

Maine senators and congressmen from both parties decided Tuesday to resubmit legislation for Passamaquoddy which died in the last Congress. This will be done next Wednesday and will lead to hearings before committees of both houses.

Passamaquoddy, Dickey and some other projects, including transmission lines to Boston, add up to a package estimated at \$206,000,000 and the Passamaquoddy total alone exceeds \$550,000,000.

It is felt the Senate would approve the whole thing fairly easily but the House of Representatives is much less certain. Some sections of the government itself are opposed, mainly because of cost.

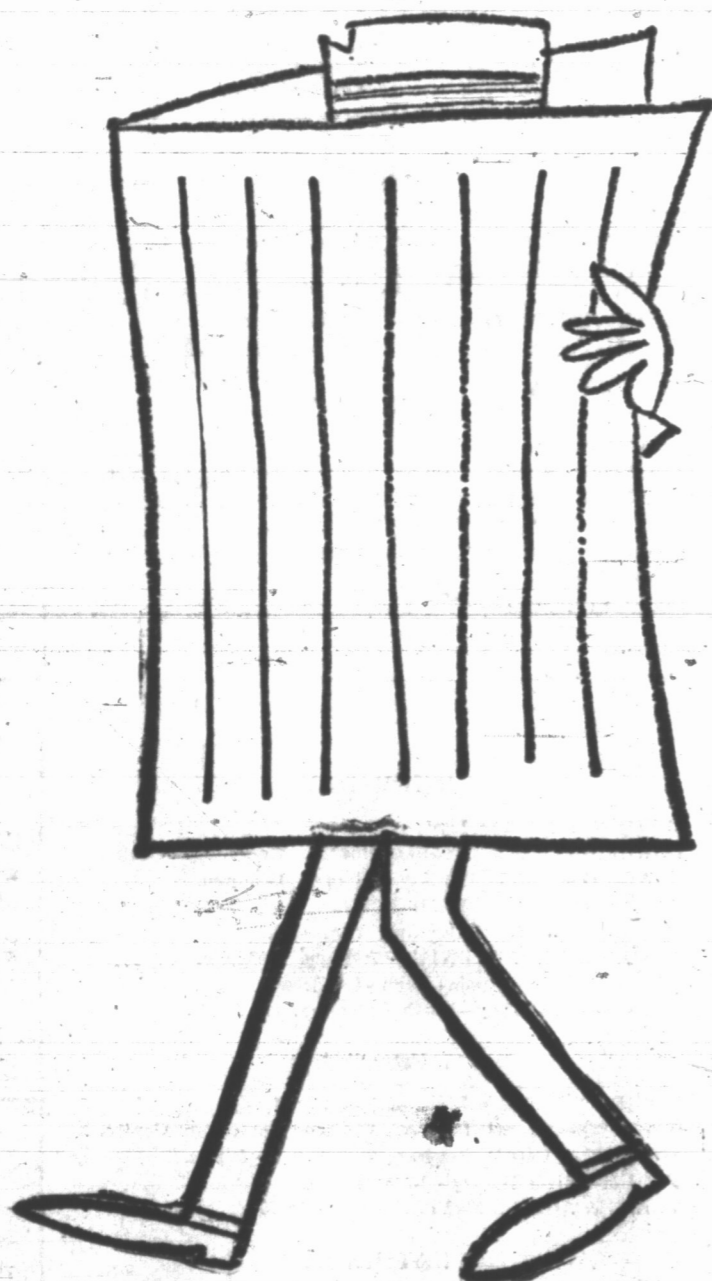
Backers of the plan, including the corps of army engineers, are prepared to argue the full economic and engineering feasibility.

The tidal-powered part would generate electricity with the ebb and flow of high tides, utilizing them through pools.

Dickey's role would be to provide a firm base of power operating 24 hours daily.

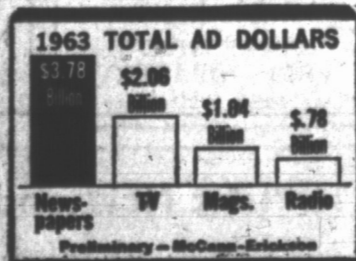
Only after congressional approval can any funds be allocated for the projects and Udall's statement has singled out Dickey dam as the immediate priority.
