This past week-end has been a memorable time in the historical annals of Oddfellowship, marking as it does the 138th Anniversary of the founding of that Fraternal Order.

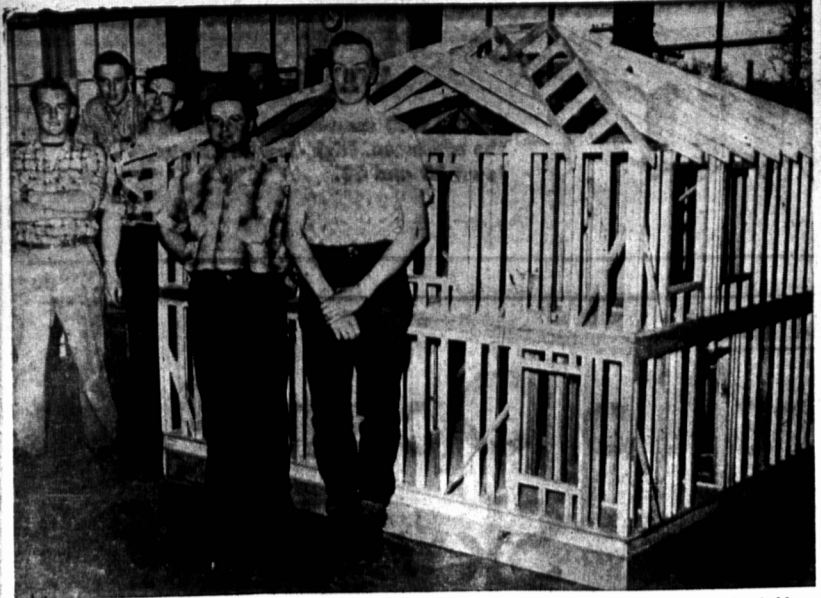
