TORONTO

TORONTO (CP) — One of the sharpest declines of the year was averted Tuesday on the stock market as fresh buying appeared in late-afternoon trading to reduce most losses by as much as one-half.
Metals dipped slightly more than a point. Golds were one-quarter of a point easier.
Because of what observers term the "attempt to beat the heat", trading was lighter than Monday and below the average of recent sessions. Final volume was 3,749,000 shares compared with Monday's 3,938,000.

Uranium was among the heavier-lipped lower-priced metals. Northspan dipped 45 cents to 67.20. St. Stanrock was off 30 cents to \$3.45. International Nickel lost 1/2 point at 103 and Hudson Bay a point at 67 1/2 among senior base metals.

A few western oils showed sizeable gains but most were lower. Security gained 25 cents at 35.30 and Canada Southern Pete advanced 20 cents to \$7.45.

Fargo was off 50 cents at \$7.10. North Canadian lost 25 cents to \$5.50. Triad, General Pete, a Canadian Atlantic, Britalia and Central Del Rio were all 15 cents lower.

Index losses: Industrials 1.88 to 485.77; golds .27 to 81.65; base metals 1.08 to 203.13; western oils .87 to 187.31.

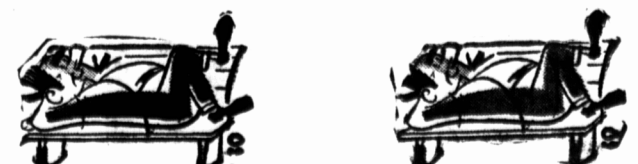
