

BIRDS: **Northern Gannet** - 1 dead on Conway sand hills on June 16 (JDM, DWi); **Snow Geese** - 4 at Cavendish Sandspit on May 10 (LT); **Eurasian Widgeon** - 1 at Pisquid Pond in mid-May (DGS), 1 at Blooming Point ephemeral pond in early Jun. (PA); **Wood Ducks** - male at Mount Albion on Apr. 9 (HJ), 6 at Cavendish lagoon on May 27 (LT); **Ring-necked Ducks** - arrived in Mount Albion on Apr. 25 (HJ); **Red-tailed Hawk** - 1 at Darlington on May 15 (JWa); UID hawk on fence post on May 16 at Hartsville (JWa), 1 at Alexandria chasing a Willet the week of May 29th (AST); **Northern Harrier** - 1 at Sharam Point Causeway on June 8 (P&AW); **Kestrel** - 1 at Parkdale on June 15 (JDMc); **Piping Plover** - 4 to 5 at Cousin's Pond (JW); **Killdeer** - pair in park in Parkdale on Apr. 16 (BB), nest with 4 eggs at Kinlock Park (RM); **Willet** - 1 nesting at Alexandria wet meadow overlooking the bay on June 3 (JDM); **Greater Black-backed Gulls** - 2 pairs on Hillsborough Piers, 1 on nest in early May; nests removed under permit on May 20th (JDM, BS); 1 pair renested 1st week of June (JDM); **Common Tern** - several back at the Hillsborough Piers on May 4 (JDM), 1 nest with egg on Hillsborough Pier # 4 on May 20 (BS); **Northern Saw-whet Owl** - 1 visited a tree in Mt. Albion on Jan. 7 (R&LM), 1 juvenile in woods at Hartsville on June 8 almost 1 year to the day from her first sighting of a Barred Owl (JWa); **Whip-poor-will** - 1 heard at Green Bay in early Apr. (JW); **Ruby-throated Hummingbird** - seen at Kinlock Road on May 25 (WC); UID Hummingbird with red cap, white throat, and red forewing area reported from Clyde River Road (JLR); arrived late this year at Bunbury with first sighting the week of May 25th (P&AW); **Pileated Woodpecker** - 1 at Boughton River on Apr. 18 (RCo); **Yellow-bellied Flycatcher** - 1 at Green Meadows on May 26 (RC); **Horned Lark** - pair at Cousin's Pond on May 5 (JW); **Swallows** - reports of a decline in Barn Swallows over the past decade continue as do comments on the scarcity of Tree Swallows, Bank Swallow colonies seem to be thriving in some areas; **Blue Jay** - P&AW report sightings down at Sharam Point while other reports submitted show no change; **Northern Mockingbird** - 1 at Brackley on Apr. 1 (RP); 1 at Meadowbank on May 13-4 (PC), 1 at Cape Turner on June 7 (DC); **Northern Shrike** - 1 at Tea Hill on Dec. 18 (BH); **Catbird** - 1 at Charlottetown on May 17 (BBa), 2 at Donagh on May 21-3 (SM); **Yellow-rumped Warbler** - seen at Hunter River on Apr. 29 (MM); **Blackpoll Warbler** - female reported at Sharam Point on May 20 (P&AW); **Northern Parula** - seen at Hunter River on May 4 (MM); **Blackpoll** - 1 at Sharam Point in May (P&AW); **Northern Oriole** - 1 at Sharam Point bog on May 20 (P&AW); 1 at Crapaud on May 28th (JDM, BB, LT, RP); **Indigo Bunting** - 1 in Mayfield on May 10 (LB); **Purple Finch** - higher numbers than usual at Sharam Point this year (P&AW); **White-winged Crossbill** - 8 seen feeding on budworms in white spruce at Macphail Woodlot (SM); **American Tree Sparrow** - 1 at Sharam Point on May 21 (P&AW); **White-crowned Sparrow** - more reports than usual this spring (LT, RP, JDM, CM); **Lincoln's Sparrow** - 2 at Donagh on May 21-3 (SM).
