

Posters Come Down Early

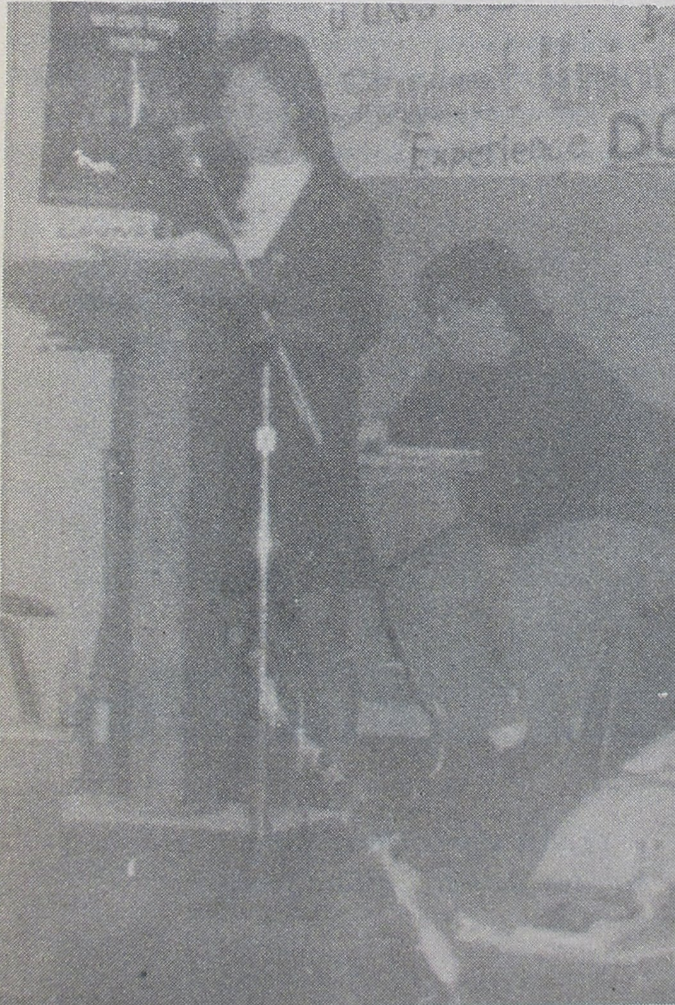
