In pain and sorrow Christ has found the ministers that tend hearts open to his love, and His church has been to them a guide to eternity and a home for the spirit. We believe, and we are glad to see, that Mr. Stead's fulness of bread and shortness of work will never be possible in this world. If they are, we shall need to pray more earnestly for grace so to pass through things temporal that we finally lose not the things eternal."

Notice to Commercial Travellers.

The attention of Commercial Travellers is called to the following sections of an Act passed by the Legislative Assembly of Prince Edward Island, Session 1893, entitled "An Act to Impose a Direct Tax on Certain Classes of Travellers." From and after the passing of this Act every trader not permanently residing in this Province, commonly known as a "Commercial Traveller" and every person not permanently residing in this Province, and who sells either for himself or any other person any goods, wares or merchandise in this Province, or changes or purchases any goods, wares or merchandise within this Province, either by the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, or simply by word of mouth without the production of samples, photographs, catalogues, printed or written matter, shall, before he or she enters this Province, or before he or she enters any part of this Province, or before he or she enters any part of this Province, or before he or she enters any part of this Province, pay to the Provincial Treasurer of this Province, an annual license fee or direct tax of fifteen dollars.
